

Ordinance Bill No 101
Ordinance No 97

An Ordinance to establish a curb line on the Streets of Lebanon and to provide the manner of the Construction of curbs and to repeal all ordinances in conflict here with

Section (1)

the people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Section (1)

that all curbs built or put in on Main Street from oak Street to Wheeler Street shall be built 12 feet out in the Street from the property line abutting on the Street

Section 2

that on all other Streets in the said city which are 60 feet or more in width the curb shall be built 14 feet out in the Street from the property line abutting on ^{the} said Streets

Section 3

that on all Streets in the ^{said} city which are 50 feet wide the curb shall be built 10 feet out in the Street from the property line abutting on the said Street.

Section 4

that on all Streets 40 feet wide the curb shall be built 6 feet out in the Street from the property line abutting on the said Street

Section 5

that the word property line as used and construed in the ordinance shall be the line separated the adjoining land from the Streets

Section 6

that all curbs built within the district of the fire limits of the said city shall be made and constructed of cement or concrete mixed in the manner and of the proportions required for cement walks for the city

and all other cement or concrete curbs where ever built in the said city shall be in like manner all cement or concrete curbs shall be not less than 16 inches deep with a base of not less than eight inches wide and the top not less than six inches wide, with the inside or property line side of such curb to be perpendicular.

Section

7

all curbs outside of the district of the fire limits of the said city may be made and constructed of either wood or cement and concrete all wooden curbs shall be made of good red or yellow fir lumber the same to be not less than three inches thick and 12 inches wide to be securely nailed to post firmly planted in the ground on the property side of the curb

Section

8

all curbs of whatever material made shall be so made and constructed that the top of the curb shall be on a level with the side walk grade of the abutting walk

Section

9

that the city of Lebanon shall not attempt to make or do any substantial grading or graveling or other improvements to the streets in the said city until curbs have been made and put in as in this ordinance provided

Section

10

that all curbs shall be made and constructed at the expense and costs of the owners of the abutting property and all the work shall be done under the supervision of the Committee on Streets and public property of the city of Lebanon and the Superintendent of Streets of the ^{said} city and such curbs shall be put in to the satisfaction of the said Superintendent of Streets as to manner and material used in the making of the same and the same laws and rules shall apply as to the making and construction of side walks

Section 11

that all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 12

this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after 30 days after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
