## Ordinance Bill No 107

## Ordinance No 103

An Ordinance providing for the opening of an Alley 12 feet wide running North and South Through the track of land or block of land bounded on the North by Grant Street on the West by main Street on the South by Maple Street and on the East by park Street in the city of Lebanon, Oregon and fixing the time for hearing any objections to opening Same.

The People of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Whereas the Common Council of the city of Lebanon in Linn County Oregon deem it for the best interest of the said city and its inhabitants to open and extend an Alley in the said city over and upon the following route and Property to wit

Beginning at a point 154 feet East of the South East-Corner of Block No 2 in the city of Lebanon in Linn County Oregon and running thence north parallel with the East-line of main Street to the South line of Grant Street thence East on the South line of Grant Street 12 feet thence South on a line Parallel with the East-line of main Street to Maple Street thence west 12 feet on the north line of Maple Street to the place of beginning

That the City of Lebanon in Linn County and the Common Council of the said city deem it for the best interest of the said city and its inhabitants to locate, and open and dedicate to the public as a public alley over and along and upon the hereinafter described land and route in the said city of Lebanon Oregon

That the line and route of the said alley way be upon along and over the following course and route beginning on the north line of Maple Street at a Point which is 154 feet East of the South East Corner of Block No 2 in the city of Lebanon <sup>in</sup> Linn County Oregon and running thence north on a line parallel with the East line of Main Street in said city to the South line of Grant Street thence East on the South line of said Grant Street 12 feet ~~wide~~ thence South on a line parallel with the said East line of Main Street to the north line of Maple Street in said city thence west on the north line of Maple Street 12 feet to the place of beginning The said alley to be a public alley 12 feet wide

That notice of the intention of the said city to open the said alley and to establish the same as and for a public alley way be served on all the owners or reputed owners of the abutting Property on the said proposed alley way and also by posting four copies of the such notices in four public places in the said city for ten days of the time and place of hearing any and all objections and remonstrances to the opening and establishing of the said alley way as herein described

That the city Council hereby fixes and sets the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1911 at the hour of 8 o'clock P M of said day at the Council Chambers in the city of Lebanon Oregon as the time and place of hearing and determining any and all objections and remonstrances against the opening and establishing the said alley way as herein described and at said time viewers and appraisers be appointed by the Council to view out and appraise and determine the benefits and damages any and all abutting property may sustain and receive by reason of the opening and establishing of the said alley way as herein provided and to do any and all other things necessary and proper in the Premises

That in as much as there is urgent need of the immediate opening of the said alley on account of the construction of a sewer system for the said city of Lebanon and the same being necessary for that purpose and the health peace and safety of the said city requiring that the sewer system be started at once and the said alley be opened immediately an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force and effect on its passage by a three fourth vote of the Council and its approval by the Mayor passed by the unanimous vote of all the Councilmen elected to the Council this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1911
