Ordinance Bill 111

Ordinance No 107

An Ordinance to establish, dedicate and confirm an alley in the city of Lebanon, Oregon, over and along the following route to wit: Beginning at a point 154 feet East of the S. E. Corner of ^{Block} lot 2 in the city of Lebanon, Oregon and running thence north on a line parallel with the East-line of main Street to grant Street thence East - 12 feet - thence South on a line parallel with the East-line of main Street to Maple Street thence west 12 to the place of beginning and authorizing the same to be made a public record.

The people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows

whereas the Common Council of the city of Lebanon Oregon, on the 13th day of June 1911 duly passed and enacted an ordinance which was duly approved by the Mayor of said city declaring it was and is necessary to open and establish an alley 12 feet wide over and upon certain property described in said ordinance and hereinafter described and

whereas on the said 13th day of June 1911 the said Council duly appointed Ed Kellenberger, BA Millsaps and Lee Bilyew as appraisers and viewers to view out and appraise and determine the benefits and damages to any and all abutting property by reason of the establishing and opening of the said alley and

whereas the said viewers did on the 28th day of June 1911 ^{filed} with the Recorder of the said city and with the Council their report in writing of their doings as such Commission which report was as follows

Lebanon Oregon June 20th 1911

To the Honorable Mayor and Common Council of the city of Lebanon Oregon, we your viewers and appraisers heretofore appointed to view out and locate and establish an alley

over and upon the following route to wit
 Beginning at a point which is 15 1/2 feet East
 from the South East corner of Block 2 in the
 city of Lebanon and running thence North
 on a line parallel with the East-line of
 Main Street to Grant Street thence East on
 the South side of Grant Street 12 feet Thence
 South on a line parallel with the East line
 of Main Street to the North line of Maple
 Street thence West 12 feet to the place of beginning
 That before proceeding to view we duly qualified
 as such viewers as by law required that in
 the opinion of your viewers and Committee
 it is necessary that the said alley be opened
 and established over and upon the said
 route for the protection of the property from
 fires and conflagration so that fire fighting
 apparatus may be taken to the rear of the
 buildings and for the further reason that it
 is necessary for one of the proposed sewer lines
 to run across the said Block on the said line
 we therefore recommend that the said alley be
 established

your viewers further find after duly and
 fully considering the matter that each ^{every} ~~and~~
 and all abutting property and the owners thereof
 will be benefited to the extent and value of
 the land and property taken for the said alley
 and we find that no benefits or damages
 should be awarded to any of the abutting property
 or the owners thereof by reason of the opening
 of and establishing of the said alley.

That the Marshall of the city of Lebanon and the Superintendent of Streets of the ^{said} city cause the said alley to be opened as herein provided at once

That a Certified Copy of this ordinance be filed and recorded in the office of the recorder of Conveyances of and for Linn County Oregon, as and for a conveyance and dedication to the public

That in as much as the said alley is a public necessity at once and the peace, safety and health of the said city requires that the same be opened and established at once an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor
