

ORDINANCE NO. 108

An Ordinance Declaring an assessment and fixing a lien for sidewalk improvements on lots 5,6,7 and 8 Block No. 5 in Wasson's Addition to Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the construction, building and making a 5 1/5 feet wide sidewalk abutting on the said lots, and making the same a lien and charge upon and against each of the said lots for the walk abutting thereon.

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1:- That whereas on the 16th day of May, 1911 a Resolution was duly passed and enacted by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, declaring it was necessary to build and construct a sidewalk 5 1/3 feet wide on the South side of Lots 5,6,7, and 8 in Block 5 in Wasson's Addition to Lebanon, and abutting upon the said lots, at the cost and expense of the owners of the said lot and fixing the time and place for hearing of any any all objections and remonstrances against the said improvements or the building of the said walk and that due and legal notice was given to the owners and reputed owners as by law required of the time and place of the said hearing of the said matter, and that the council met in pursuance thereof, and no objection or remonstrances were made or filed against the said improvement and the building and making the said walk, that the said Council duly passed and enacted an ordinance which was approved on the 20th day of June, 1911, declaring the time and manner of the construction of the said walk and directing the recorder to advertise for bids therefor, and thereafter and on the 18th day of July, 1911, bids were duly received and opened by the council in open meeting for the construction of the said walk and the lowest and best bid therefor was filed by Geo. S. Childs and the contract was duly awarded to him, and he entered into a contract for the construction of the said walk as by law provided, and the street superintendent having reported that the work had been done

and completed according to the contract and according to law and the costs of the construction of the said walk and the advertising for bids and other necessary and legal costs were the sum of \$80.00

Section 3:- That there be and there us hereby assessed upon and against each of the said lots ~~that~~ in the said Block the sum of \$20. that the cost and expenses were the same on each lot and the said sum of \$20.00 is the proportional costs for each lot and is the ~~cost~~ costs properly to be assessed upon and against each of the said lots That the work is done according to the contract and ordinances of said City and the Charter of the said City and the said sum and ~~the~~ amount shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a lien upon and against each of said lots in the sum of \$20.00 owned by the said George W. Stimpson, trustee until the full amount of the said sum and sums be paid and received and a record of the lien and levy be entered in the lien docket of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and the recorder be and he is hereby directed to give notice to the said owners or reputed owners of the said lots of the assessment of the said costs upon the lots above described for the said amount so made and if the same sum and amounts is not paid within ten days after giving notice thereof, as by law required the said recorder shall issue a warrant for the collection of the said amounts, the same to be directed to the City marshal of Lebanon, Oregon, to forthwith levy upon and sell the said lots as upon execution and as by law required and provided.

Section 3:- That in as much as the health, peace and safety of the City of Lebanon, requires that this ordinance be effective at once and the ~~the~~ health peace and safety of the said city will be greatly preserved by this Ordinance going into effect at once an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

Passed by the Council this 6th day of September, 1911 having received the unanimous vote of all members elected to the council take by an aye and nay vote.

Ordinance Bill No 112

Ordinance No 108

An ordinance declaring an Assessment and fixing a lien for sidewalk improvements on lots 5-6-7 and 8 in Block No 5 in Wassons Addition, to Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon for the construction building and make a 5 ⁷/₃ feet wide sidewalk abutting on the said lots, and making the same a lien and charge upon and against each of the said lots for the said walk abutting thereon

The People of Lebanon do ordain as follows

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That whereas on the 16 day of May 1911, a Resolution was duly passed and enacted by the Council of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, declaring it was necessary to build and construct a sidewalk 5 ⁷/₃ feet wide on the south side of lots 5-6-7 and 8 in Block 5 in Wassons Addition and abutting upon the said lots at the cost and expenses of the owners of the said lots and fixing the time and place for hearing of any objections and remonstrances against the said improvements on the building of the said walk and that due and legal notice was given to the owners and reputed owners as by law required of the time and place of the said hearing of the said matter that the said Council met in pursuance thereof ^{on the 20th day of June 1911} and no objection or remonstrance ever made or filed against the said improvements and the building and making the said walk, that the said Council duly passed and enacted an ordinance which was ^{on the 20th day of June 1911} duly approved by the Mayor declaring the time and manner of the construction of the said walk and directing the Recorder to advertise for bids therefor and thereafter and on the 18th day of July 1911 Bids were duly received and opened in the Council meeting for the construction of the said sidewalk and the lowest and best bid therefor was filed by Geo S Childs and the contract was duly awarded to him,

and he entered into a contract for the construction of the said walk as by law provided and the Street-Surpassintendent having reported the work done and completed according to the contract and according to law and the costs of the construction of the said walk and the advertising for bids and other necessary and legal costs were the sum of \$80⁰⁰

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that there be and there is hereby assessed upon and against each of the said lots in the said Block the sum of \$20⁰⁰ that the costs and expenses were the same on each lot and the said sum of \$20⁰⁰ is and proportional costs for each lot and is the costs properly to be assessed upon and against each of the said lots that the work is done according to the contract and ordinances of the said city and the charter of the said city and the sum and amount shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a lien upon and against each of the said lots in the sum of \$20⁰⁰ owned by the said George W. Stimpson trustee until the full amount of said sum and sums be paid and received and a record of the said lien and levy be entered in the lien docket of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and the Recorder be and he is hereby directed to give notice to the said owners or reputed owners of the said lots of the assessment of the said costs upon the lots above described for the said amounts so made, and if the said sum and amounts is not paid within ten days after giving notice thereof as by law requires the said Recorder shall issue a warrant for the collection of said amounts the same to be directed to the city Marshall of Lebanon Oregon to forth with levy upon and sell the said lots as upon execution and as by law required and provided,

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That in as much as the health and peace and safety of the city of Lebanon requires that this ordinance be effective at once and the health and safety and peace of the said city will be greatly preserved by this ordinance

going into effect at once, an emergency is hereby
 declared this ordinance shall be in full force
 and effect from and after its passage by the
 Council and approved by the Mayor
