ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND EMPOWERING THEM MAYOR AND RECORDER TO PURCHASE LOT 5 IN BLOCK ONE IN J. M. RALSTON'S THIRD ADDITION TO LEBENON, OREGON. AND PROVIDING THE MANNER AND MONEY OF PAYING THEREFOR.

## THE PEOPLE OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1:- That the mayor and recorder of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed in the name of and for the use and benefit of the said City of Lebanon, to purchase from Kata Ralston, Lot five in Block One in J. M. Ralston's Third Addition to the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, at a price not to exceed the sum of Fifty Dollars a front foot on Main street, and not to exceed the aggregate sum of \$3300.00 for the said lot, and to pay for the same by a warrant on the city of Lebanon drawn on the general funds of the said City.

Section 2:- That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the said City not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of paying for the said lot, the sum of \$3300.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary and required to pay for the said lot.

Section 3:- that on the making, execution and delivery of the said deed to the said lot by the said Kalston, the owner, with an abstract showing a good and sufficent title clear from defects liens and incumbrances to the satisfaction of the said mayor, the said recorder is hereby directed to issue and draw a warrent on the treasurer of the said city and deliver the same to the said owner of the said lot in payment therefor. The same to be issued

drawn and paid as other warrants of the and city, are issued and paid.

Section 24- That is as much as the said city has no suitable hall building or place in which to keep its records, and to stire its fire fighting aparatus, and has no place in which the council can meet and do the business of the said city, and that is it necessary that the city build such a place as soon as possible, and the city has no suitable or fit ground of lot on which to build such a hall, and the health, peace and safety of the said sity requires that such a hall be erected as speedily as possible and that the said city acquire the title to a fit lot at once for such purpose, an emergency is herevy declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
