ORDINANCE NO. 116.

An Ordinance authorizing, empowering and directing the mayor and recorder of the City of Lebanon, to enter into a contract with J. W. McArthur and C. A. McClain, co-partners, to do the engineering work for the City of Lebanon, Oregon, in connection with the construction of a sewer system, and to provide for the compensation for such services and the manner of payment for same.

Section I.- That the said J. W. McArthur and C. A. McClain shall do all the engineering, both consulting and supervising necessary to complete the sewer system according to the plans, specifications and contracts already made or as may hereafter be provided in accordance therewith, The more important details of the proposals are as follows:

- (1) To make all necessary surveys, both preliminary and permanent necessary for the construction of the said sewer system.
- (2) To carry into effect the ~~construction~~ *design* of a sewer system sufficient and adequate for the needs of 10,000 people.
- (3) To make all necessary maps, profiles and such other details as may be required, and all necessary data and descriptions for rights of way.
- (4) They shall supervise the construction of all parts of the system that it may be deemed advisable to build at this time or that is undertaken and built at this time under the contract for the said system.
- (5) To furnish, without additional cost, to the City, competent assistants and inspectors to aid in making surveys and inspecting the work during construction.
- (6) They shall furnish such monthly or other estimates during the

progress of the work as may be required as a basis for the payment of the contractor under the terms of his contract.

(7) They shall furnish final records, maps, profiles, and data, showing location of all y's t's and branches and all other specials and all openings or plings in the said sewer lines, and all inlets to the said sewer lines. And they shall, at all times, give to any City Official all such advice as may tend to make the said sewer system a success.

(8) They shall execute all other details not specially mentioned that may be necessary in the construction of said sewer system, and such as are usually a part of the work of an engineer in the construction of such a system, the same as if the same were specially mentioned herein.

(9) If, at any time, the said engineers shall wilfully neglect or refuse to perform the services heretofore mentioned, **the council shall** ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ engineer ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ and ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ farm ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~, have the right to discharge them. It being further understood that upon their discharge, the said engineers shall receive full compensation for all services rendered.

(10) The said J. W. McArthur and G. A. McLain shall receive for their services, to be paid by the City of Lebanon out of the sewer fund, as a part of the construction of the same, the sum of \$2600.00, the said sum to be paid as follows:

(e) A monthly allowance of \$ 200.00, to cover expenses up to the time that construction begins.

(b) \$ 300.00 per month during construction or until in all \$ 1600.00  
have been paid. The remaining \$ 1000.00 to be paid when the work is  
completed. The sum of all payments to equal \$2600.00.

## Section 2,

That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, be, and they are, hereby empowered, authorized and directed to enter into a contract

in writing, with the said J. W. McArthur and C. A. McClain, for the doing and performing the labor and services as provided for in this Ordinance, and in and by which the City of Lebanon shall undertake and promise to pay, unto the said J. W. McArthur and C. A. McClain the said sum in the manner and in the amount as herein provided.

Section 3.

That in as much as it is necessary that the engineering work, on the said sewer be commenced at once, and the health, safety and peace of the City of Lebanon, requires that this Ordinance be in full force and effect at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and full this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Section 4.

Passed by this Council this 1<sup>st</sup> day of March, 1912, the same having received more than a three-fourths affirmative vote of all the members elected to the Council taken by an aye and nay vote.
