ORDINANCE NO. ¹¹³114

An Ordinance to provide for the payment of engineering working and for engineers services in connection with the paving of streets of the city of Lebanon, Oregon, and to provide for the manner and time of making such payments, and to prescribe the duties of such engineers in such work.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

J.W McArthur the
Section 1- That the duties of ~~taxxxted~~ engineers heretofore duly appointed and elected to do the engineering work for the city of Lebanon in connection with the pavings of the streets of the said city shall be as herein provide and such as may be ordered and prescribed by the council from time to time, by motion, resolution or otherwise. The principal duties of the said engineers shall be to make all necessary surveys, plans, specifications profiles, estimates and probably cost of same at such times as the council may require, and all other engineering work necessary in connection with the paving of the said streets. He shall also superintend the construction and work of making the said pavings doing all that may be necessary for that purpose.

Section 2- The said engineer shall be paid the sum of \$ six for each and every day he is employed on the said work and his necessary expenses for board and railroad fare in connection with the said work and necessarily incurred therein.

Section 3- That the said engineer shall not make any extra charge for consultation or as consulting engineer in connection with the said paving except for the time acutally employed as herein provided, except further any actual expenses in connection therewith.

Section 4- That the said engineer shall do any work necessary to be done during the time of the said paving in connection with the sewer as relates to the paving, or the establishing of streets grades

or other city engineering he shall be paid the same per diem as when engaged in engineering work on the paving.

Section 5- The city shall provide any and all assistance necessary to the said engineer in the carrying on of the said work and shall pay the same usual and customay pay or such as may be agreed upon.

Section 6. The payments to the said engineer shall be made monthly as other bills are paid against the said city.
