Section 1, Sand Sof An Ordinance to amend, Ordinance No. 40 of the city of Lebanon, Org gon, duly enacted and passed by the council on the 4th day of Mebruary 1896, entitled An Ordinance relating to the taxing of dogs and to regulate their running at large within the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and to define what shall constitute the same, and to provide for the impounding and killing of the same

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows:Section L. That section on of the said Ordinance No. 40 be amended
so as to read as follows:

Section 1- Any person or persons owning anyxexxkespingxaxxxxes or keeping within the city of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, any male or female dog or dogs shall pay a year y tax and lieanse thereon for each male dog One Dollar and for each female dog Two Dollars owned or kept by him in the said city, which said sum shall be due and paye able on the 1st day of June, of each and every year, and all alix dogs on which the said license and tax is not paid to the city recorder on or before the 1st day of June, of each and every year, or for any years in the manner as herein after provided, the said dog on which such license is not so paid shall be disposed of as herein after provided. The word payent as used in said ordinace shall mean and refer to the 1st day of June of each year, the time the said sum is due and payable.
