ORDINANCE NO 128
120

An Ordinance to create and establish a cement sidewalk District, and to provide for the manner and material to be used in the construction of sidewalks in such districts

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1- That there is hereby created and established in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a cement sidewalk district comprising the following streets and parts of streets. to-wit:-

Main street from the North line of A. street to the South line of Wheeler street; Second street from the north line of Oak street to the south line of Academy Street; Park street from the North line of Maple street to the to the South line of Rose street; Grant street from the East line of Third street to the west line of Williams street; Sherman street from the east line of Fifth street to the West line Grove street.

Section 2- That hereafter all new sidewalks built within the said cement sidewalk district shall be built and constructed of cement, sand and gravel in the manner and of the proportions, and under the supervisions as now provided for the building and construction of cement sidewalks in the City of Lebanon.

Section 3- That in all other parts of the City of Lebanon where there are now are may hereafter be constructed cement sidewalks in the manner as provided by ordinances of the said city, one half or more of the lenial feet of any block abutting upon a street, ~~sidewalks~~ ~~walks~~ then thereafter there shall be no new sidewalks ~~be~~ built or constructed other than cement sidewalks made and constructed as provided in the ordinances of the said city of Lebanon, for building

such walks.

Section 4-

When any wooden walk within the said cement sidewalk district shall from any cause become or be in such condition that in the judgment and opinion of the superintendent of streets and the committee on Streets and public property, ~~that any wooden sidewalk is in such condition as~~ not to be fit to be repaired, then on the order of the council of the said city a new cement sidewalk shall be built and constructed in place thereof, in such time as the council may order, and in the manner as by ordinances of the said city provided.

Section 5- All Ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6? This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty days after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor,
