An Ordinance to prohibit the use of sidewalks in the City of Lebanon for roller skates and coaster wagons.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1- That it shall be unlawful for any person to use any side walk in the City of Lebanon, Oregon for roller skating or for coaster wagons. And it shall be unlawful for any person to skate upon any sidewalk in the said city on roller skates or to coast upon any side walk in the said City in or upon any wagon, cart, truck or other vehicle.

Section 2- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$25.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 12 days in the City jail.

Section 3- That on account of reckless skating on roller skates upon sidewalks and the running of coaster wagons on the said sidewalks in the city of Lebanon, the peace and quiet of the City is greatly disturbed, and grave injuries to persons on the sidewalks are likely to occur, and the peace, health and safety of the said City is endangered thereby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

Passed by the Council this 18th day of February, 1913, the same having received more than three-fourths affirmative vote of all members elected to the council taken by ye and naye vote on the roll call of the council.

Approved by the Mayor this 27th day of February, 1913.
