passed by the Council of 5th day of May, 1910 and approved by

the manner of construction of curbs, and to repeal all Ordinances
in conflict herewith.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:Sec One, Taht Section one of Ordinance No. 97, passed by the
Council of the 5th day pf May, 1910 and approved by the Mayor on
the 8th day of May, 1910 entitled "An Ordinance to establish a
curb line of the streets of Lebanon, and to provide the manner
of construction of curbs, and to repeal all Ordinances in confrictnerewith", be and the same is hereby amended so as to read
as follows.

Section 17 That all curbs built or put in on Main street from

Street to Wheeler Street shall be built 12 feet out in the
street from the property line on abutting on said street. All
curbs built on Sherman street from Third Street to the alley
east of Main street and west of Park street, be built out 12 feet
from the property line abutting on said street. And all curbs
bult on Grant street from Second street to Park street be built
out in the street 12 feet from the property line abutting on said
street
