ORDINANCE NO. ^{133,} ~~136~~ 126

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WIDENING OF THE SIDEWALK ON PARTS OF MAIN STREETS, ON PARTS OF SHERMAN STREET AND ON PARTS OF GRANT STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1- That the cement sidewalks on Main street from the north line of Maple street to the South line of Ash street be widened to 12 feet.

Section 2- That the sidewalks on shermann street from the west line of Main street to the first alley west of Main street be widened out to 12 feet.

Section 3 - That the sidewalk on Grant street from the ~~west~~ ^{First alley east} of Main street to the first alley west of Main street be widened out to 12 feet.

Section 4- That the said walks be made and constructed of cement and gravel in the manner and of the proportions as by ordinance provided for the construction of cement sidewalks.

Section 5- That in as much of the said streets are to be paved during the coming summer and it is necessary that the said sidewalks be widened out to the curb line on the said streets before the work of paving begins, and the said paving is to begin at July 1st, 1913, it is therefore necessary that this ordinance be in full force and effect at once, that the said walks can be out in at once, and the peace health and safety requires that the walks be completed at soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the council by the ~~xxxxx~~ approval by the mayo

Section 6- This ordinance passed by the council this 6th day of May, 1913, the same having received the unanimous vote of all members elected by the council taken by aye and nae vote on the roll call of the council.
