ORDINANCE BILL NO. 137 /34

An Ordinance to amend Section one of Ordinance No. 33 passed by the Council on the 20th day of April, 1909 and approved by the mayor on the 20th day of April, 1909, entitled " An Ordinance to regulate the meaner and place of setting Electric Light Poles, Telephone Poles or other poles set in the Streets and alleys of the City of Lebanon, and to provide for the punishment for any violation of this Ordinance." and Declaring an emengency."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBAHON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

ORDINANCE NO. 4

Section 1. That section One of Ordinance No. 88 passed by the Council on the 20th day of April, 1909 and approved by the mayor on the 20th be and the same day of April, 1909, is hereby amended so as to read as follows.

Section I. All Electric Light poles hereafter set in any street in the city of Lebanon, and all Telephone poles Street car poles and all other poles for wires set in any street in said City of Lebanon, in Linn

County, Oregon, shall be so set that the center of the said pole shall top

ne 18 thickes towards the property line from the outer edge of the Curb Line in said street, and all wires for any one service shall be of uniform height on the same side of any street, provided that at railroad crossings, or street car crossings on any street the wires and poles shall be at such height as may be convenient for trafic on such lines.

Section 2.

That in as much as it is necessary that Electric light and telephone poles be properly places at once on account of the paving of certain streets, the health. safety and peace of the City of Lebanon requires that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinanceshall be in full force, and affect from and after its approvalished.

This ordinance received the affirmative vote of all members elected to the council taken by aye and nae on the roll call of the council. Passed by the Council this 23rd day of may, 1913.
