ORDINANCE NO. ~~126~~ <sup>135</sup> 128

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 120, passed by the Council on the 19 day of July 1913 and approved by the Mayor on the 19 day of July 1913, entitled an ordinance to create and establish a cement sidewalk district, and to provide for the manner and material to be used in the construction of sidewalks in such district.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 120 passed by the council on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 1913, and approved by the mayor on the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 1913, entitled an Ordinance to create and establish a cement sidewalk district, and to provide for the manner and material to be used in the construction of sidewalks in such district, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows.

Section 1. That there is hereby created and established in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a cement sidewalk district comprising the following streets and parts thereof, to-wit:-

Main street from the North line of A. Street to the South line of Wheeler street; Second Street from the North line of Oak street to the South line of Academy street; Park street from the North line of Maple street to the south line of Rose street; Maple streets from the East line of Second street to the West line of Park Street; Grant street from the East line of Third Street to the West line of Williams street; Sherman Street from the East line of Fifth street to the West line of Grove street; Ash street from the East line of second street to the west line of Park street; Vine street from the East line of Third street to the West line of Park street .

Section 2;-

That inasmuch as it is necessary that certain streets in the said city be improved at once and that certain sidewalks in said district be improved, it is necessary that this ordinance become effective at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and the



health, safety and peace of the said city requires that this ordinance become in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

This ordinance was passed by the Council this 3rd day of June 1913 the same having received the unanimous vote of all members elected to the council taken by aye and nay upon the roll call of the council and entered in the journal.

Approved by the Mayor this 3rd day of June, 1913.
