ORDINANCE NO. ~~141~~

An Ordinance to amend section One of Ordinance No. 53 passed by the council on the 17th day of February 1903 and approved by the mayor on the 18th day of February, 1903, and entitled an ordinance relating to cattle ~~xxxxxxxkxxxxkxgax~~ and prohibiting their running at large within the City of Lebanon, and providing for the impounding and sale of the same, and to repeal Ordinance No. 41, entitled "An ordinance relating to Cattle and regulating their running at large within the City limits and providing for the impounding and sale of the same, Approved February 19, 1896.

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows:-

Section 1. That section one of Ordinance No. 53, passed by the Council on February 17, 1903 and approved by the Mayor on the 18th day of February 18, 1903, entitled An Ordinance relating to cattle and prohibiting their running at large within the City of Lebanon, and providing for the impounding and sale of the same, and to repeal Ordinance No. 41, Entitled " An Ordinance relating to Cattle and regulating their running at large within the City limits and providing for the impounding and sale of the same" Approved Feb. 19, 1896, be and the same is hereby ~~xxxxxxxkxxxxkx~~ amended so as to read as follows:-

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any horse, mare, jack, jennett, mule, bull, cow, steer, heifer, calf, or cattle, sheep, goats hogs or shine, or other cattle or animals of any kind to run or be at large or be herded in or upon any street, alley, park or public place in the corporate limits, or upon any right of way or easement in said city, or upon any private premises or vacant lot or grounds in the said city except those of the owner of such animal <sup>when</sup> ~~except~~ being driven through said city for shipment or other purpose, then shall be driven carefully and under control unless the owner or person having charge of such animals shall first have and obtain the assent and permission of the owners of such lot or premises to herd the said animals on such lots or premises, and then they



shall be heard or staked so as not to be permitted to go upon or over any side walk or into any street or alley or public park . Any person who shall willfully turn any of said animal into any street, alley, or public park or onto any private lands or lots, or who shall neglectly, or careless permit or allow such animals to go or be ~~at large~~ at large in the streets, alleys or on any private lots or grounds in th the said city, or who shall carelessly and neglectly leaves any gates, fences or barn doors in such condition that such animals may or shall get out into the strets or alleys or on any private land or lots, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor ando upon conviction thereof before the recorders court shall be fined not less than \$10.. nor more than \$100.00 for each offence,
