ORDINANCE NO. 139 143.

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An Ordinance declaring an assessment on all adjacent and abutting property and property particularly and specially benefitted by the improvement of Grant street, from the East line of Second street to Park street by paving the same for the full width of the road way with Gravel Bitulithic pavement in the following manner:

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By grading the street to proper sub-grade, By paving the roadway of said street the full width with Gravel 2. By paving the roadway of said street the full which with Grav Bitulithic pavement with full intersections, By laying and constructing Gravel Bitulithic headers, By constructing proper inlets and catch basins, By constructing proper vitrified sewer pipe drainage, By constructing concrete curbs where not already constructed,

and declaring same a lien upon said property and directing the Recorder to enter liens in the Docket of City Liens against the property assessed for said improvement and to collect the same.

Whereas on the 6th day of May, 1913, after due and proper pro-ceedings duly had and enacted by the Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, the Recorder of the said City of Lebanon did, by direction of the Common Council of the said City of Lebanon, advertise for bids for the making of said improvements on Grant street, from the East line of Second street to Park street, by paving the same with Gravel Bitulithic pavement for the full width of the road way as follows:

By grading the street to proper sub-grade,
By paving the roadway of said street the full width with Gravel Bitulithic pavement with full intersections,
By laying and constructing Gravel Bitulithic headers,
By constructing proper inlets and catch basins,
By constructing proper vitrified sewer pipe drainage,
By constructing concrete curbs where not already constructed, and

Whereas in pursuance of said advertisement the Warren Construction Company, a Corporation, filed a bid for making said improvement and doing said work, and being the lowest responsible bidder therefor, and the bid being the lowest and best bid offered, the contract was duly let to the said Warren Construction Company for the making of said improvement and doing said work; and by authority of the said Common Council of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, the Mayor and Recorder of the said City entered into contract in writing on behalf

of the said City with the said Warren Construction Company for the making of said improvement and doing said work, and

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Whereas the said improvements have been fully completed, and the report of the City Engineer has been accepted by the Common Council and filed with the Recorder showing the total cost of said improvement, and the said work has been done and completed to the satisfaction of said City Engineer and to the satisfaction of the Committee of the Council on Streets and Public Property, and to the satisfaction of said Council,

Whereas on the <u>M</u> day of November, 1913, the Council duly enacted and adopted Resolution No. 16 accepting the improvement of said street as fully completed in accordance with the terms, conditions, and within the time provided in the said contract,

> NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That the total cost of improving Grant street, from the East line of Second street to Park street, by paving the same in the following manner:

By grading the street to proper sub-grade, By paving the roadway of said street the full width with Gravel Bitulithic pavement with full intersections, By laying and constructing Gravel Bitulithic headers, By constructing proper inlets and catch basins, By constructing proper vitrified sewer pipe drainage, By constructing concrete curbs where not already constructed 1. 2. 5. 4. 5. By constructing concrete curbs where not already constructed, 6. under and by virtue of the contract herein before referred to and mentioned, for the making of said improvement in the City of Lebanop Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby declared to be the sum of \$5041.17 and the amount assessed against the abutting and adjacent property and property particularly and specially benefitted thereby. is the sum of \$4798.31, which said sum is hereby declared to be a lien upon the property abutting thereon and adjoining the streets and parts of streets thus improved, and particularly and specially benefitted thereby, and apportioned as hereinafter provided; and each lot, tract and parcel of land is hereby declared to be particularly and specially benefitted and improved to the extent of the amount

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assessed against it as hereinafter apportioned and set down.

Sec. 2. The cost of making the improvements referred to in Section One (1) hereof, is hereby apportioned and assessed to each lot, tract and parcel of land to the extent of the respective and proportionate shares of the full value of the improvements upon each lot, tract and parcel of land as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 3. The Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to enter up all liens in the Docket of City Liens of the City of Lebanon, according to the provisions of this ordinance as set forth in Section Two (2) hereof, and the Charter of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and the laws of the State of Oregon.

Sec. 4. As soon as this Ordinance shall have been passed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon and approved by the Mayor of said City, the Recorder shall and is hereby directed to give notice of said assessment by publication in the "Lebanon Express", of Lebanon, Oregon, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, which said notice shall be published in at least four (4) consecutive weeks in said newspaper; and he shall also give notice of said assessment by posting 4 copies thereof in 4 of the public places in said City of Lebanon; Which said notices for publication and posting shall substantially contain the matters required to be contained in the Docket of City Liens, and shall require payment of said assessment within ten (10) days from the date of the final publication of said notice, and said notice shall also state that the owner or owners of the lots, tracts, or parcels of land adjoining the street improved and subject to the assessment, may make application within ten (10) days from the date of first publication, or posting of the said notice to pay their reapective assessment in installments as provided under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Oregon, known as the Bancroft Bonding Act, as set forth in Section 3245, Chapter 5 of Title XXVI of Lord's Oregon Laws, and acts amendatory thereof; and if said assess - ments are not paid, or the aforesaid application filed for bonding the said property, within the time herein before required and as provided by law, then and in that case the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to issue warrants for all delinquent assessments to the Marshal of the said City of Lebanon, requiring the said Marshal to forthwith levy upon such lot or part thereof, or tract or parcel of land upon which the assessment is unpaid or for which an application for bonding has not been filed according to law, and sell the same as by law provided, and in all matters and things pertaining to the collecting of said delinquent assessments, and do and perform every act and deed by law required.
