ORDINANCE NO. 148,

The use of

An Ordinance regulating and preventing the driving of traction engines upon the paved streets of the City of Lebanon,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take or drive any traction engine, which has corrugated, plated, tread or other rough surface wheels, upon any pavement in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, provided, however, that persons desiring to cross a paved street with such engine may do so by putting down planks upon which to drive said engine, in such manner as to thoroughly and securely protect the pavement from injury from such engine.

Sec. 2. ^x It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive any ^{+ or to drive any} vehicle upon any pavement in the City of Lebanon, which has tires or wheels of such material or made in such manner as to damage such pavement, ~~or any~~ ^{or any gravel wagon except with a tight box or bed} provided, however, that this Section shall not apply to ordinary vehicles with tires having a smooth wearing surface, and this Ordinance shall not apply to engines having wheels or tires with perfectly smooth wearing surface, provided the engines are not greater weight than 10 tons.

Sec. 3. That any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of the City of Lebanon, shall be punished by fine not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than one hundred (100) dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail not less than five (5) days nor more than fifty (50) days.

Sec. 4. That inasmuch as there has been considerable pavement recently completed in the City of Lebanon, and the same is in danger of damage and injury by reason of driving thereon with heavy traction engines, the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon requires that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
