

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE No. 152.

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 111 in the matter of regulation of billiard and pool rooms.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 111, being an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to license, regulate, tax and restrain certain callings, trades and employments in the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, and to define what shall constitute the same, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses therefor, and to provide for the punishment of any violation of this ordinance, and to repeal Ordinances No. 54, 66, 71, 90, and 92, and all other ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance", be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Passed and approved on 5 day of Dec. 1911
"Section 10. No women or girls shall be allowed to frequent, loiter about or be in any room or rooms or place where any billiards or pool are being played for hire or profit, or where billiard or pool tables are kept for hire or profit. And no minors shall be allowed to frequent such places, or play at such games, or loiter about or be in any room or place where such games are played." *and all such rooms and places shall be open at*

Adopted by the City Council on the 31 day of March, 1914. *all places to full view from the street*

Approved by the Mayor on the 3rd day of March, 1914.
