A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 154.

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 9, in respect to the duties of the City Treasurer.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section Twenty-eight (28) of Ordinance Number Nine (9), being an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance relating to the duties of the officers of approved on the 15th day of September, 1891, the City of Lebanon", be, and the same is hereby, amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 28. When any city warrant hereafter issued shall be presented to the City Treasurer, and there is no money in the treasury to pay the same, the treasurer shall endorse on the back thereof: 'Presented and not paid for want of funds. warrant bears interest at 6% per annum from 19 (inserting date of presentation), payable semi-annually.'; and shall sign said endorsement in his official capacity. Thereafter, said warrant shall bear interest at six per cent. per an-num, payable at the office of the City Treasurer seminum, payable at the office of the dity Treasurer semiannually on January 1st and July 1st, subject to the
right of the City to call said warrant for payment
at any time on ten (10) days published notice. The
Treasurer shall keep a record of such warrants, in
a book kept for that purpose, showing the date, number
and amount of the warrant, on what fund drawn, the
name of the drawee, by whom presented, and date of
presentation; and, whenever any such endorsed warrant
shall be paid by the Treasurer, he shall cancel the
same, as other warrants are canceled by him, and note same, as other warrants are canceled by him, and note such payment opposite the entry of such warrant in said record book. He shall also endorse on each warrant so registered, and note on the record thereof, the date and amount of eacg payment of interest made thereon."
