

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 159.

An Ordinance requiring the use of mufflers on motor vehicles.

- - - - -

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all automobiles, motor cycles and other motor vehicles driven or operated within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall be equipped with "mufflers" which shall be kept closed so as to muffle the exhaust of the engines on such machines at all times while the same are being driven or operated on any paved street within said corporate limits, and at all times when the same are being driven or operated on any other street or alley within said corporate limits when any horse or team is on any street or alley within one block of said motor vehicle.

Section 2. Any person who shall drive or operate, or cause to be driven or operated, within the corporate limits of said city, any automobile, motor cycle or other motor vehicle, in violation of Section One (1) of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50), or by imprisonment for not less than one day nor more than fifty days, or both.

Passed by unanimous vote of the Council this 5th day of May, 1914.
