A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 173

An Ordinance to prevent spitting on walks, and in other public places, and prescribing penalties therefor.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to spit upon and sidewalk or cross-walk, or any walk or steps leading to any church, public hall, depot, waiting room or other public place, or upon the floor of any church, public hall, depot, waiting-room or other public place, within the City of Lebanon.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 of this prdinance shall, on conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars, or by **imprisonment** for not less than five days nor more than twenty-five days.
