

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 178.

An Ordinance to prevent poultry running at large
within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or person having charge of any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys or other poultry to permit the same to be or run at large upon any of the streets or alleys of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, or to trespass upon the property of anyone other than such owner or person in charge of such poultry within the corporate limits of said City.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of Section One of this ordinance shall, on conviction thereof, be fined not less than ten (10) dollars, nor more than twenty-five (25) dollars.
