A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 179

An Ordinance fixing and levying an assessment upon the several lots, parcels and tracts of land specially benefited by the improvement of that part of Grant Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, extending 'from the West curb line of Park Street Eastward to the City limits.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 165 of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, passed by the Common Council, and approved by the Mayor, of said City, on the 26th day of May, 1914, entitled "An Ordinance providing for the improvement of that part of Grant Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, extending from the West curb line of Park Street Eastward to the City limits", provision was made for the improvement, in the following manner, of that part of Grant Street described in the title of said ordinance:

- By grading the street to a proper sub-grade;
   By paving the roadway thereof for a width of thirty-two (32) feet with hard-surface pavement, the particular kind of such pavement to be thereafter determined;
- 3: By laying and constructing headers where necessayy;
- By constructing proper inlets and catch-basins;
   By constructing concrete curbing where the same had not already been constructed;

AND WHEREAS, in pursuance of said Ordinance No. 165,

and in accordance with the terms and provisions thereof, and after due advertisement for bids for said work, as by said ordinance required, the said Council, after consulting the wishes of the owners of the property to be affected by said improvements, and in accordance with the expressed desire of the owners of a large majority of the property to be specially benefited by said improvements, decided to use portland cement concrete as the paving material therefor; and the bid of G. T.

Morgan being the best and lowest of those wherein portland cement

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concrete was specified to be used as the paving material, said bid was duly accepted as to all of said improvements except the curbing; and the bid of E. L. Keebler being the lowest and best as to said curbing, the same was duly accepted for the construction of the curbing;

and whereas the Mayor and Recorder of said City did thereafter, on the 8th day of July, 1914, in pursuance of the terms of Ordinance No. 169 of said City, passed and approved on the 7th day of July, 1914, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to enter into a contract in writing with on behalf of the said City with G. T. Morgan, of Portland, Oregon, for the improvement of that part of Grant Street, in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, extending from the West Curb line of Park Street Eastward to the City limits", enter into a contract, on behalf of said City, with said G. T. Morgan, for the execution by him of said work so awarded to him;

AND WHEREAS said Mayor and Recorder did thereafter, on the 5th day of August, 1914, in pursuance of the terms of Ordinance No. /7/ of said City, passed and approved on the 4th day of August, 1914, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, to enter into a contract in writing on behalf of said City with E. L. Keebler, of Lebanon, Oregon, for construction of certain curbing on Grant Street", enter into a contract, on behalf of said City, with said E. L. Keebler, for the execution by him of said work so awarded to him;

AND WHEREAS all of said work and improvements hereinbefore and in said Ordinance No. 165 mentioned and specified,
have been done and completed, and said contractors have fully
completed their work, and the same has been found satisfactory
by the City Engineer and the Common Council, and has been duly
accepted by the Common Council;

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AND WHEREAS, it was provided by said Ordinance No.

165 that the cost of all of the grading for said improvements, and the cost of paving the street intersections, should be borne and paid by said City, from the general fund, and that the remainder of the cost of said improvements should be borne by the adjacent property and property specially benefited thereby;

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AND WHEREAS, the total cost of all of said improvements, as reported by the City Engineer, is Fifteen thousand one hundred twenty-one and 88/100 dollars (\$15,121.88), and the total cost of the grading, and of paving the street intersections, is Three thousand nine hundred thirty-three and 87/100 dollars (\$3,933.87), and the remainder of the total cost, aside from said grading and intersections, is Eleven thousand one hundred eighty-eight and Ol/100 dollars (\$11,188.01);

AND WHEREAS, the Common Council has found and determined that each of the lots, parcels and tracts of land hereinafter described is specially and peculiarly benefited by said improvements in the amount hereinafter assessed against it; Now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the total actual cost of all of the improvements mentioned and described in the preamble of this Ordinance was and is the sum of Fifteen thousand one hundred twenty-one and 88/100 dollars (\*15,121.88); that the total actual cost of all of the grading, and of paving the street intersections, was and is the sum of Three thousand nine hundred thirty-three and 87/100 dollars (\*3,933.87), which amount is to be borne by said City, from the general fund; that the total actual cost of the remainder of said improvements is the sum of Eleven thousand one hundred eighty-eight and Ol/100 dollars (\*11,188.01), which amount is to be assessed against the adjacent property and property specially benefited.

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Section 2. That the several lots, parcels and tracts of land hereinafter described are specially and peculiarly benefited by said improvements to the extent of the respective sums hereinafter indicated and in proportion thereto, and the said sum of \$11,188.01 is hereby proportioned and assessed upon and against said several lots, parcels and tracts (owned, as nearly as can be assertained, by the persons named), respectively, as follows, to-wit:
