1068 ORDINANCE NO. 192.

An Ordinance naming, and re-naming, certain streets in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and repealing conflicting ordinance provisions.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a certain street situated in the Northwest part of said City, the name of which has not heretofore been officially designated, and which street is described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Wasson's Addition, which point is on the West side of Northe Maint Street, and extending West to the right-of-way of the Oregon & California Railroad Company, being a 60-foot street; shall be hereafter known and designated as MARY STREET,

Section 2. All that part of the street heretofore known as Olive Street which is situated in Mountain View Addition shall hereafter be known and designated as HARRISON STREET.

Section 3. That the name SECOND STREET is hereby extended so as to embrace not only the street heretofore known and designated as such, but also that part of the street along the South side of the Academy, or High School, grounds which lies West of the East line of Second Street (as heretofore designated) extended, and which has heretofore been known as Academy Street; and also the that street lying along the West side of said Academy, or High School, grounds, and North from the Northwest corner of said grounds, and which has heretofore been known as Montague Street.

Section 4. That the street in Hylands Addition heretofore known as Taft Street shall hereafter be known and designated as SEVENTH STREET.

Section 5. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be, and the same are hereby, insofar as they so conflict, repealed.
