

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 *for 1915*.

1069 ORDINANCE NO. 193.

An Ordinance establishing a City Base, or plane of reference for elevations, and fixing the elevation of a Primal Bench Mark.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the official City Base or plane of reference for elevations in the City of Lebanon is hereby fixed at a point 100 feet below the top of that certain Bench Mark in the top of a concrete monument, located 2.25 feet South and 9.3 feet West of the North West corner of Lot No. 5, in Block No. 1, in J. M. Ralston's Third Addition to the City of Lebanon, said Lot 5 being the property of the City of Lebanon, and located at the South East corner of Main and Maple Streets.

Section 2. The above described Bench Mark consists of a plate of white brass, embedded in concrete, and inscribed with the words and figures, "Primary B. M. Lebanon, Ore. Ele. 100.00 A. D. 1914," and is hereby declared to be the Primal Bench Mark of The City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon. The elevation thereof is 100 feet above the City Base.

Section 3. All official elevations here¹after established in the City of Lebanon shall be described, with reference to their elevation, as compared with the official base, in feet and decimal parts of a foot. No grade or official elevation shall be established other than by ordinance, and in the manner described in this ordinance.
