Ordinance Bill No. 20 for 1915.

ORDINANCE No. 200.

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of certain fire apparatus and equipment.

- - - - -

WHEREAS the City of Lebanon is in need of certain fire apparatus and equipment, as hereinafter mentioned, and prices on the various items needed have been procured, and the prices submitted by A. G. Long, of Portland, Oregon, as hereinafter mentioned, are found to be satisfactory, and as low as said goods can be purchased for; therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor of said City is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in writing with A. G. Long, of Portland, Oregon, for the purchase from the said A. G. Long, by the said City of Lebanon, of the following fire apparatus and equipment, at prices not in excess of those herein specified, to-wit:

One hose cart, - - - - -	\$125.00
200 feet of 2½" 4-ply rubber hose, double cotton-jacketed, "Keystone" brand, @ \$1.10 per foot,	220.00
One shut-off nozzle,	12.50
50 firemen's badges, @ 50¢ each,	25.00
	----- \$382.50

Section 2. Inasmuch as the present fire apparatus and equipment of said City is inadequate, and there is immediate need of the apparatus and equipment above mentioned, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
