

Ordinance Bill No. 23 for 1915.

ORDINANCE NO. _____.

An Ordinance to regulate the height of Awnings.

- - - - -

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for the owner or occupant of any building or premises in the City of Lebanon to erect, place, maintain or permit any awning to extend from such building or premises out over the sidewalk on any atreet unless the framework of said awning shall be at least seven (7) feet above the sidewalk.

Section 2. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined not less than ten dollars (\$10) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50); and each day that said awning shall remain in violation of this ordinance after complaint is filed shall constitute a separate and additional offense.
