4 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING, EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR  
5 AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON? TO ENTER INTO A  
6 CONTRACT IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, WITH J. C.  
7 MAYER, S. P. BACH AND SAM'L M. GARLAND, FOR THE RENTAL OF THE  
8 HALL KNOWN AS THE YEOMAN HALL, LOCATED IN THE BUILDING SITUATED  
9 ON THE SOUTH 43 FEET OF LOT 2 IN BLOCK 3 IN THE CITY OF LEBANON,  
10 OREGON, FOR A TERM ONE YEAR WITH OPTION AND PRIVILEGE OF CON-  
11 TINUING THE TERM FOR FOUR ADDITIONAL YEARS AT A RENTAL OF \$240  
12 A YEAR.

13 WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Oregon, is in need of a suitable  
14 hall and place for the meetings of the common council of the  
15 said City, and for other municipal purposes, and the said Hall  
16 known as the Yeoman Hall is the most suitable and available  
17 hall and place for such purposes, which said hall is situated  
18 in the rear part of the second story of the Brick and Cement  
19 building situated on the South 43 feet of Lot 2 in Block 3 in  
20 the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and is owned by the said J. C. Mayer  
21 S. P. Bach and Sam'l M. Garland, and

22 WHEREAS, the said owners have made an offer to the said city  
23 to lease unto the said City the said hall for a term of one  
24 year with the option and privilege of the said City to extend  
25 the said lease for a period of four years additional for a rental  
26 of ~~\$240.00~~<sup>\$20.00</sup> a ~~year~~<sup>month</sup> for the whole of the said term the said to be  
27 paid monthly at the rate of \$20.00 a month, the said rental to  
28 begin on the 2nd day of January, 1917, Now Therefore,

29 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

30 SECTION 1. That the Mayor and recorder of the City of  
31 Lebanon, Oregon, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized  
32 and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the said  
33 J. C. Mayer, S. P. Bach, and Sam'l M. Garland, for the rental of  
34 the said hall for all municipal purpose, meetings of the council,  
35 meeting of the fire department, for public library, commercial  
36 club meetings, public meeting, and for any other legal meetings

1 which the said city may desire to hold in the said hall.

2  
3 SECTION 2. The said hall to include the main assembly hall,  
4 the dining room and kitchen of the Yeoman Hall, with the priv-  
5 illage and use of the lavatory, sinks and wash basins and toilets.

6  
7 SECTION 3. The owners of the said Building shall provide  
8 proper heat for the said hall to keep the same comfortable for  
9 all the said meetings, and shall furnish all lights and light  
10 fixtures for same, <sup>except light globes</sup> at their own proper expense and without  
11 charge to the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and the said  
12 \$20.00 a month shall be in full for the said hall, and for said  
13 heat and lights.

14  
15 SECTION 4. That in as much as the said City has not  
16 hall of its own and no place of its own in which to meet, and  
17 the health, safety, and peace of the said City requires that  
18 the said city procure some suitable place in which to meet at  
19 once an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance  
20 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage  
21 by the Council and approval by the mayor.

22 SECTION 5 That this ordinance received more than three-  
23 fourths of all the votes of the member elected to the council  
24 taken by ye and naye votes upon the roll call.
