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SECTION 2, The said hall to include the main assembly hall, the dining room and kitchen of the Yeoman Hall, with the privillige and use of the lavatory, sinks and wash basins and toilets.

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SECTION 3. The owners of the said Building shall provide proper heat for the said hall to keep the hame comfortable for all the said meetings, and shall furnish all lights and light except light globes fixtures for same, at their own proper expense and without charge to the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and the said 320.00 a month shall be in full for the said hall, and for said beat and lights.

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SECTION 4. That in as much as the said City has not hall of its own and no place of its own in which to meet, and the health, safety, and peace of the said City requires that the said city procare some suitable place in which to meet at once an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinane shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the mayor.
