ORDINANCE NO. 2/D

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and pecorder to Purchase Certain furniture for the use of the city and Council.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEABNON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1 That Whereas, the City of , ebanon has no sufficient furnitute for the use of the Council and city officers, and the needs for additional furniture is urgent, and Whereas, the Lodge of Yeoman of ebanon, have some furniture that they have no need of which is in good condition and suitible for the use of the City, of Lebanon, to meet all the cities requirements, and they are willing to seel the same to the city for much less th than the city can otherwise purchase the same or like furniture. That the said furnitute so needed and which the said SECTION 2 Yeoman Lodge desires to sell is as follows:-

43 Opera chairs: 45 fording chairs, One Carpet and one large rug, 12 fir mission chairs, Two officers tables,

SECTION 3 . That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon Oregon, are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to purchase the said furniture mentioned in section 2 of this ordinance of and from the said Yeoman Lodge of Lebanon, Oregon, and pay therefor the sum of \$150.00 by warrant of the City of rebanon, the said payment to be made when the said Lodge can furnish good title to the said furniture free from incumbrance or liens.

That in as much as the said city is in need of the Section 4 said furniture and has none for use at this time, the health, Safety and peace of the City requires that this ordiance shall be in full force and effect frankanikaftarkitakkpangaga, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the council and approval

by the Mayor. Passed by the Council this 20th day of march, 1917 the same having received more than trhee fourth of all the votes of all members elected to the Council taken by aye and may votes on roll call and entered in the journal of the Council.
