3                           ORDINANCE NO. 210

4           An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to Purchase  
5           Certain furniture for the use of the city and Council.

7           THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEABNON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

8  
9           Section 1       That Whereas, the City of Lebanon has no sufficient  
10           furnitute for the use of the Council and city officers, and the  
11           needs for additional furniture is urgent, and Whereas, the  
12           Lodge of Yeoman of Lebanon, have some furniture that they have  
13           no need of which is in good condition and suitable for the use  
14           of the City, of Lebanon, to meet all the cities requirements,  
15           and they are willing to seel the same to the city for much less th  
16           than the city can otherwise purchase the same or like furniture.

17           SECTION 2       That the said furnitute so needed and which the said  
18           Yeoman Lodge desires to sell is as follows:-

19           43 Opera chairs: 40 folding chairs, One Carpet and one large  
20           rug, 12 fir mission chairs, Two officers tables,


21           SECTION 3 . That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon  
22           Oregon, are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to purchase  
23           th said furniture mentioned in section 2 of this ordinance of  
24           and from the said Yeoman Lodge of Lebanon, Oregon, and pay there-  
25           for the sum of \$150.00 by warrant of the City of Lebanon, the said  
26           payment to be made when the said Lodge can furnish good title to  
27           the said furniture free from incumbrance or liens.


28           Section 4       That in as much as the said city is in need of the  
29           said furniture and has none for use at this time, the health,  
30           safety and peace of the City requires that this ordiance shall  
31           be in full force and effect ~~from and after its passage~~ at once, an  
32           emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in  
33           full force and effect upon its passage by the council and approval

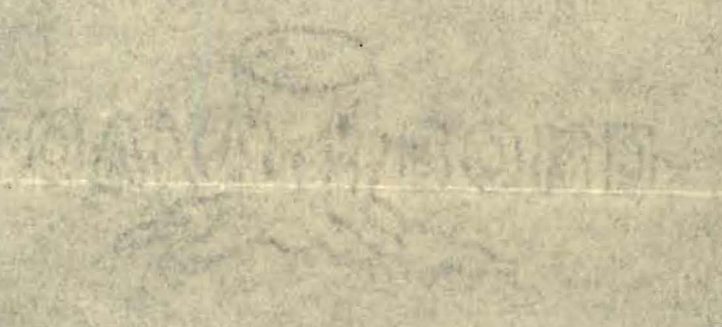
1 by the Mayor.

4 members elected to the Council taken by aye and nay votes on  
5 roll call and entered in the journal of the Council.
