

ORDINANCE BILL NO 3 FOR 1917

ORDINANCE NO 212

An Ordinance to regulate the manner in Which Licenses
for any calling, occupation, trade, bussiness
or employment shall be granted.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1.- That no original license shall be issued until the applicant therefor shall have first made application in writing to the license committee of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, in which said application such applicant shall state fully the business or things to be done or performed under such license, the place where the business is to be done or carried on, and the time or term for which the license is desired. If the said committee approve of the same and the said business or things to be done, and that the business or things to be done will be carried on according to law, they shall endorse on the said application their approval, and reccommend that that the license be granted to the applicant. The said applicant shall thereupon present the said application with the said endorsement together with a receipt from the city treasurer for payment in full of the amount of the license required for the said full term of the said license, whereupon the said recorder shall issue to the said applicant a license which shall authorize the said applicant to carry on and conduct the said business calling and things provided for in the said application and license

Section 2-. If the said committee does not approve of the said application and things to be done and refuse to so reccommend the same, the said applicant may present the said application to the Common Council for approval at the next or any subsequent meeting of the said council for the approval of the said council

1 and if the said council shall approve the same the said license
2 shall be granted as if the same had been approved and recommended
3 by the said committee, but if the council refuse or fail to ap-
4 prove the same the license shall not be granted.

6 Section 3-. That in all other respects all licenses shall be
7 issued and paid for as provided in Ordinance No. 111 as passed
8 by the common council on the 5th day of December, 1911, and
9 approved by the Mayor on the 5th day of December, 1911.

11 Section 4-. That Whereas the health, safety and peace of the
12 City of Lebanon, Oregon, requires that this Ordinance be in
13 effect at once this ordinance shall be in full force and effect
14 from and after its ~~approval~~ passage by the council and approval
15 by the mayor.

17 section 5-. Passed by the Council this 15th day of May, 1917
18 by the unanimous vote of all member elacted to the council taken
19 by an aye and nay vote upon the roll call of the Council.
