3 An Ordinance to amend Section 8 of Ordinance No. 111 passed  
4 by the Council of the City of Lebanon on the 5th day of Dec-  
5 ember 1911 and approved by the mayor of the said City on the  
6 5th day of December 1911, entitled "An ordinance to license  
7 regulate, tax and restrain certain callings, trades and Employ-  
8 ments in the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, and to  
9 define what shall constitute the same, and to provide for the  
10 manner of issuing licenses therefor, and to provide for the  
11 punishment of any violation of this ordinance, and to repeal  
12 Ordinance No. 54, 66, 71, 90, and 92 and all other ordinances  
13 and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance.

14 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

15  
16 Section 1. That Section 8 of said ordinance No. 111 be and the  
17 same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

18 Section 8. That the owner, or proprietor or the keeper of any  
19 billiard table, pool table, or combination Billiard-Pool Table  
20 in the city of Lebanon, kept or maintained for hire or profit, or  
21 or for which is made for the playing on the said tables shall  
22 pay a license therefor as follows:-

23 \$30.00 a year for one table. \$50.00 a year for two table, \$60.00  
24 a year for Three table, and \$10.00 a year for each additional ta-  
25 ble. No license shall be used for less than one year, and  
26 all license for billiard or pool tables shall be taken out  
27 for one year and paid for in full in advance for one year be-  
28 fore they are used for hire or profit. All billiard or pool  
29 tables operated on one license shall be under one management  
30 and conducted in the same room or building, and if operated  
31 in separate rooms or separate buildings they shall pay  
32 for and have separate licenses for each building, for the tables  
in each building or room.
