ORDINANCE BILL NO 2121 for 1917

ORDINANCE No. 2004

An Ordinance to regulate the speed and traffic of Automobiles, Motor Vehicles, Motor Cycles, Engines, Trains, Cars, Bicycles, Carriages, Street Cars, and all other travel on the streets of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, within the corporate limits of the said City, and to provide for the parking of cars within certain limits of the said City, and to provide for the punishment of any violation of this Ordinance, and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows:—

Ordain as Follows:—

Section 1. No person, drvier or operator or person in charge of any Automobile, Motor Cycle, Motor Vehicle, Bicycle, Electric Car, Railroad Engine, Railroad Train, or any Carriage, Wagon or other vehicle or in charge of any team, horse, or other animal on any street, alley or public highway or public thoroughfare within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall drive, operate or move, or permit the same to be driven, operated or moved at a rate of speed greater or faster than the speed specified and designated in Section two of this Ordinance.

nance shall be as follows: Main Street from Maple Street to Ash Street from Park Street to Second Street from Park Street to Second Street from Main Street to Sherman Street from Main Street to Third Street from Main Str

conclusively to be unreasonable.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the City Marshal of the City of Lebanon to place in a conspicuous place on each Main street leading into the city where the boundary line of the said City crosses the said street a sign of sufficient size to be easily seen and read by persons using the said street, giving in plain letters the rate of speed allowed on the said street or part of such street, and at the point where the rate of speed is lowered he shall also place a similar sign in a conspicuous place giving the rate of speed allowed thereon.

Section 4. No Automobile team or

Section 4. No Automobile, team or vehicle or Motor Vehicle shall oe left standing on Main Street between Ash and Maple Streets for a longer time than thirty minutes at any one time between sunrise in the morning and sunset in the evening of the same day,

or in front of any store, place of business or residence for a longer time than thirty minutes without the consent of the owner or occupant of the said building, store or residence, except on Sunday and public holidays.

Section 5. No cars shall be parked on the South side of Grant street or the North side of Sherman street within the fire limits of the said City, for a period longer than thirty minutes at any one time, except on Sundays and Public Holidays. All cars parked on the said streets within the fire limits and intended to be left for a period longer than thirty minutes shall be parked on the North side of a period longer than thirty minutes shall be parked on the North side of Grant street and the South side of Sherman street. On all other streets not herein before restricted cars may be parked on any street and on either side of the street.

Section 6. The rules and laws for street and road traffic in the City of Lebanon shall be as follows:

(a) A vehicle meeting another shall pass to the right.

(b) A vehicle overtaking another shall pass to the left and not pull over to the right until entirely clear of the one passed.

Turning.

(c) A vehicle turning into a street to the right shall turn the corner as near the right hand curb as practicable.

to the left shall go beyond the center of the intersection of the two streets.

Keeping to Right.

(e) A vehicle shall keep over, as near as practicable, to the right hand curb so as to leave the center of the street free and open for overtaking traffic; the slower the speed the near-

er the curb.

(f) A vehicle shall not make a turn to reverse its direction at any place where traffic will be obstructed, but shall go round the block or go to a street intersection wide enough or free enough to turn round without interfering with traffic.

Stopping and Parking.

Stopping and Parking.

(g) No vehicle shall stop with its left side to a curb, and all vehicles and cars parked on any street shall stand with their right side to the curb.

(h) A vehicle waiting in front of an entrance to a building shall give way promptly to a vehicle arriving to take up or set down passengers.

(i) A vehicle shall not be parked in front of an entrance to any building, or so as to interfere with the free access to such entrance, except while loading or unloading.

(j) A vehicle shall not be left on a crosswalk or in such position as to prevent another vehicle from moving up close to and parallel with the curb in front of the entrance to a building, or so as to prevent another vehicle or so as to prevent another vehicle from moving away, or within ten feet of a fire hydrant.

(1) A parked car or vehicle shall not occupy a space more than 12 feet from the curb and shall head out the curb in the direction of traffic.

(m) A vehicle, unless parked, shall not stand backed up at an angle to a curb, except while loading or unloading, and if horse-drawn and with four wheels, the horses shall stand parallel with the curb, faced in the direction of traffic.

(n) A vehicle shall not stop in any street, except near the curb, or, so as to obstruct a crossing unless to allow another vehicle to cros its path.

Right of Way.

Section 7. (a) Emergency vehicles shall have the right of way, and fire vehicles and fire hose, and vehicles conveying fire apparatus and hose carts shall have the right of way over all others.

(b) A vehicle approaching a street intersection has the right of way over vehicles approaching the same intersection on its left.

(c) A vehicle shall not so occupy the street as to obstruct traffic.

(d) a vehicle on the approach of fire apparatus shall immediately draw near to and parallel with the curb and (5)

stop, and the fire apparatus keep near the center of the street.

Signals.

Section 8. (a) A driver slowing down, stopping or turning shall give timely signals as follows: If turning to right outstretched arm on right of car; if turning to left with out-stretched arm to the left; if stopping, either arm outstretched and then suddenly dropped, which to make certain

(b) The driver of a vehicle before backing, shall give ample warning and avoid injury to other vehicles and

pedestrians.

(c) A vehicle desiring to pass another going in the same direction shall other going in the same direction shall give one blast of the whistle, horn or other device, and if the overtaken vehicle does not give way, three such blasts or strokes shall be given, and on failure to give way, he may pass at the first opportunity where he can safely do so, without further signal (d) It shall be the duty of every overtaken vehicle to give way by driving to the right side of the road, giving at least half the road, where it can be safely done, but no vehicle shall try or signal to pass where it is not safe to pass.

electric car or motor cycle shall allow any person under the age of bixton years to drive or operate any such vehicle owned by him in or upon any street, highway or public thoroughfare within the City of Lebanon.

Section 14. All motor vehicles and automobiles and motor cycles appoaching a team or passing any team shall be under full control of the driver or operator thereof, and such driver or operator shall use due care and dilligence to prevent accident or runaway, and if such team becomes frightened, fractious or apparently unmanageable he shall stop his vehicle or machine and shall render such assistance as the circumstances shall demand, to prevent accident, runaway or injury.

Responsibility.

Responsibility.

Section 15. The driver or person in charge of a vehicle when any offense under this ordinance is committed shall be deemed the responsible person and liable to the penalties hereunder.

Duty of Officers.

Section 16. In all localities where traffic is congested and where any marshal, policeman or constable, conspicuously displays his star and discharges the duty of regulating traffic in such congested district, shall signal any vehicle to take a direction or to stop, or proceed, for the safety of the public, it shall be the duty of such vehicle to obey said directions (9)

and to comply with the orders of such

Definitions.

Section 17. (a) The term street shall apply to any part of a public highway intended for vehicles and generally known a roadway.

(b) The term "curb" shall apply to and mean the extreme edge of the street, or roadway.

(c) The term "vehicle" shall apply to and mean any conveyance whether drawn by horses or otherwise.

(e) The term "Motor vehicle" shall apply to and mean any vehicle propelled or driven by any power

propelled or driven by any power other than muscular.

(f) Bicycles shall be included in the term "vehicle" and shall be governed by the rule and regulation of this ordinance, as to traffic.

(g) The term "driver" shall apply to and mean any rider, driver or leader of a horse and to a person who draws or pushes a cart or vehicle and the driver or operator of a bicycle, motor cycle and automobile or other vehicle.

(h) The term "parked" shall ap-(n) The term "parked" shall apply to and mean any waiting vehicle and to vehicles drawn up along side one another not parallel to the curb. Section 18. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Penalties.

Section 19. Any person or persons

Emergency.

Section 20. That in as much as there are becoming a large number of automobiles and motor cycles in Lebanon and vicinity and the streets are narrow and at times much congested in certain parts of the city, and several serious accidents have been narrowly averted within the last few days, and there is imminent danger of serious accident or death from careless and reckless driving of the same, and the health, peace and safety of the said city and its inhabitants requires that this ordinance shall be come effective at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the council and approval by the may-

Section 21. This Ordinance passed by the Council on this 18th day of October, 1917 more than three-fourths of all members eloted to the council voting in favor of the passage of the ordinance by aye and nay vote taken upon roll call of the council and entered in the journal of the counc'l as follows: Ayes six nays None.
