

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 4 FOR 1918.

ORDINANCE NO 223

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE OVER THE LEBANON AND SANTIAM CANAL ON SOUTH MAIN STREET, IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON; AND APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAME.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.- That Whereas, the Bridge over the Lebanon and Santiam Canal on South Main Street in the said City is in a dangerous condition from old age and decay, and the safety of the public is endangered thereby, and there is urgent need that a substantial bridge be constructed at said point without delay, Now therefore the superintendent of streets and the the committee on Streets and Public Property of the said City are hereby authorized, directed and instructed to cause to be built and constructed without delay a concrete bridge over the Lebanon and Santiam Canal on South Main Street in the city of Lebanon, to same to costs not to exceed the sum of \$1620.00 the estimate of the Engineer for the State Highway commission, who has prepared plan and specification therefor the same to be build and constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor prepared and submitted by the State Highway commission and filed with the recorder of the City of Lebanon, on the _____ day of _____ 1918,

Section 2.- That there is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the said city the sum of \$1620.00 or such much thereof as may be necessary for that purpose, to pay for the material and labor and cost of the construction of the said bridge, the itemized bills for same to be audited by the said committee and superintendent and presented to the common council of the said city for allowance as other bills against the said city, and to be paid by the warrants

1 of the said city as other claims against the said city are
2 allowed and paid.

3 Section 3.- That the said Committee and Street Superintendent
4 are hereby authorized and empowered to employ all labor and
5 procure all necessary materials for the construction of the
6 said bridge in accordance with the said plans, at the expense
7 and cost of the city of Lebanon, but not to exceed the said
8 estimated costs in the said sum of \$1620.00
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10 Section 4.- In as much as the present bridge over the
11 said canal at said pint is in a dangerous condition, and
12 there is a very large travel on the said street and over
13 the said bridge, the peace, health and safety of the said
14 city requires that this ordinance shall be in full force and
15 effect at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
16 this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
17 after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
18 Passed by the Council this 17th day of September 1918, by
19 the unanimous vote of all member elected to the council taken
20 by aye and nay vote on the roll call and entered in the
21 journal of the council.
