1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 5 FOR 1918

4 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE OVER
5 LABANON AND SANTIAM CANAL ON GROVE STREET, IN THE CITY OF
6 LEBANON, OREGON, AND APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF
7 SAME.

8 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

9 SECTION 1.- That whereas the Bridge over the Lebanon and
10 Santiam Canal on Grove Street is in a badly decayed and rot-
11 ten condition so as to be and is in a dangerous condition,
12 and a new wooden bridge should be constructed at said point
13 without delay, Now Therefore, the Superintendent of Streets
14 of the said City and the Street committee of the council, of
15 the said city are hereby authorized, empowered and directed
16 to cause to be build and constructed a wooden bridge over the
17 Lebanon and Santiam Canal on Grove street in the City of Lebanon
18 without delay, the same to cost not to exceed the sum of \$450.00
19 the estimate of the superuntendent of street of the said city,
20 the same to be done and made according to the plans and specifi-
21 cations therefor submitted by the Street superintendent of the
22 said City of Lebanon, Oregon, which said plans ans specifications
23 were filed with the recorder of the s-aid City on the _____ day
24 of _____ 1918.

26 SECTION 2:- That there is hereby appropriated out of the general
27 funds of the said city the said sum of \$450.00 or so much thereof
28 as may be necessary or sufficient for the purpose of building the
29 said bridge according ~~the~~ to the said plans and specifications,
30 andfor the labor and material therefor, the itemized bills and
31 statement for same to be audited by said commieetee and super-
32 intendent of streets and presented to the council of the said city

1 for allowance as other bills and claims against the said city, a
2 and to be paid by the warrant of the said city as other claims
3 against the city are paid.
4

5 SECTION 3-- That the said Committee and street superintendent
6 are hereby authorized and empowered to employ all labor and
7 procure all necessary material for the construction of the said
8 bidge in accordance with the plans therefore, at the expense of
9 the said city, of Lebanon, Oregon, but not to exceed the said
10 sum of \$450.00 the estimated cost thereof.

11 SECTION 4.-- That in as much as the present bridge over the
12 said canal on said Grove street is in a dangerous condition
13 and there is considerable travel on the said street and over
14 the said bridge, the peace, safety and health of the said city
15 requires that the said bridge be built without delay, an emer-
16 gency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be
17 in full force and effect from and after its passage by the
18 council and approval by the mayor.

19 Passed by the Council this 17th day of September 1918, by the
20 unanimous vote of all members elected to the council taken by
21 an aye and nay vote on the roll call of the council and the vote
22 entered in the journal of the council proceedings.
