

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 117 FOR 1918

2 ORDINANCE NO. 230

3 An ordinance to fix the compensation of firemen of Lebanon,
4 Oregon, limiting the number of fireman, for said city, and to pro-
5 vide penalties for non attendance of firemen at fires, and to
6 provide for payment for hauling fire apparatus to fires.

7 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

8 SECTION 1.- That the compensation of the Lebanon firemen
9 of the Lebanon Volunteer fire department shall be as follows:-

10 For each firemen actually attending a fire and assisting in
11 fighting the same the sum of \$1.50 for each fire.

12 For each fireman actually attending the monthly meeting of
13 the fire company of which he is a member, the sum of \$.50
14 for each meeting, providing the city shall not pay for more
15 than 12 meeting in any one year.

16 For each member actually attended a fire drill of the company
17 the sum of \$.50 for each drill, provided the city shall not pay
18 for more than 10 drills in any one year.

19 For any person who shall haul any hose cart, hook and ladder
20 truck, or chemical engine to any fire with any vehicle or
21 team, or motor car, at the request of the chief of the Lebanon
22 fire department or foreman of any such company, the sum of
23 \$2.00 for each such vehicle for each hauling.

24 Provided, that when a false alarm is turned in, or an alarm
25 in which no water is used, or no apparatus is used, then in
26 that event the pay of the said members of the said department
27 shall be one half the sum herein provided for fighting of fires.

28 Section 2:- It shall be the duty of the said fire department
29 or the chief of the said fire department to divide the said
30 city of Lebanon, into at least two fire wards or fire divis-
31 ions, with proper fire alarms or signal for each, and that one
32 hose cart shall be kept in each of the said wards or divisions.
That the said system of fire alarms shall provide for a general
alarm, which shall call out the entire department, and an alarm
for each fire ward or division which shall call out certain
companies and apparatus. In the first instance, except by special
order of the chief of the department or some specified officer

1 of the department, the alarm shall call out ~~is~~ the chemical
2 engine company, and the hose company in the ward or division
3 in which the fire is located, only, and then if the chief
4 of the fire departments deems it necessary, the hook and ladder
5 company, or the rest of the department may be called out.

6 On any ^aalarm being turned in the chemical engine company and
7 the hose company in the ward or division where the fire is
8 located shall proceed to the fire with all possible dispatch,
9 and the remainder of the company hold themselves in readiness
10 to respond if called, but shall not proceed to the fire until
11 called by proper alarms or signals from the chief or other of-
12 ficers of the company authorized to give same.

13 Section 3- Before any bills are paid for the services
14 specified in section one of this ordinance, the chief of the
15 fire department shall certify the same to the council to the
16 effect that the persons claiming such compensation actually at-
17 tended the fire or meeting or drill for which such services
18 is claimed, or hauled to apparatus to the fire as provided
19 herein, and that he belonged to the company called out at
20 the said fire,

21 Section 4- That any member of the said Fire department who
22 neglects or fails to attend any fire or help to fight the same,
23 when attending the same, or fails to attend any fire meeting
24 or fire drill duly called, shall be penalized a sum equal to
25 the amount of the compensation he would have been entitled to re-
26 ceive, had he actually attended the same, in addition to not
27 receiving any pay for such fire or meeting, or drill, which
28 said sum shall be paid to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and if
29 the said sum is not paid, the same shall be deducted by the
30 City recorder from the next allowance to such member for at-
31 tending any fire, meeting or drill, to the amount of such pen-
32 alty. Provided, however, if the chief of the fire department
shall certify to the council that such member was at the time

1 of such fire, meeting or drill, sick and unable to attend the
2 same, or was out of the city at such time, then such member
3 shall be relieved of such penalty.

4 Section 5:- That the membership of the said Lebanon Fire
5 department shall be limited to Thirty Members in good standing
6 and the said city of Lebanon, shall not be required to pay for
7 more than thirty members attending any fire, drill or meeting
8 of the said department, nor for more than 10 drills or 12 m-
9 monthly meeting in any one year.
