2 ORDINANCE NO. 236 3 An ordinance to fix the compensation of firemen of Lebanon, Oregon, limiting the number of fireman, for said city, and to poor vide penalties for non attendance of firemen at fires, and to provide for payment for hauling fire apparatus to fies. 4 5 6 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: -7 8 SECTION 1 .- That the compensation of the Lebanon firemen 9 of the Lebanon Volunteer fire department shall be as follows :-10 For each firemen actually attending a fire and assisting in 11 fighting the same the sum of \$1.50 for each fire. For each fireman actually attending the monthly meeting of the fire company of which he is a member, the sum of \$.50 for each meeting, providing the city shall not pay for more then 12 meeting in any one year. 12 13 14 For each member actually attended a fire drill of the company the sum of \$.50 for each drill, provided the city shall not pay for more than 10 drills in any one year. 15 16 For any person who shall haul any hose cart. hook and ladder truck, or chemical engine to any fire with any vehicle or team, or motor car, at the request of the chief of the Lebanon fire department or foreman of any such company, the sum of \$2.00 for each such vehicle for each hauling. 17 18 19 Provided, that when a false alarm is turned in, or an alarm 20 in which no water is used, or no apparatus is used, then in 21 that event the pay of the said members of the said department 22 s all be one half the sum herein provided for fighting of fires. 23 Section 2:- It shall be the duty of the said fire department 24 or the chief of the said fire department to divide the said 25 city of Lebanon, into at least two fire wards or fire divis-26 ions, with proper fire alarms or signal for each, and that one 27 hose cart shall be kept in each of the said wards or divisions. 28 That the said system of fire alarms shall provide for a general 29 alarm, which shall call out the entire department, and an alarm 30 for each fire ward or division which shall call out certain 31 companies and apparatus.
