3 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF
4 THE IMPROVEMENT OF WHEELER STREET AND TANGENT STREET IN THE
5 CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, BY LINN COUNTY.

6 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

8 Section 1. WHEREAS, The County of Linn hauled and spread
9 on Tangent street in the City of Lebanon at the request of
10 the common council of the said city of Lebanon, 310 yards of
11 river crushed gravel from its gravel pit, and that the reason-
12 able value of the said work was and is the sum of 80¢ a yard,
13 and whereas, the said county furnished to the city *from its*
14 gravel bunkers about 65 yards of gravel for other streets
15 of the said city used and hauled by the said city and the
16 reasonable value of such gravel was and is the sum of 45¢ a
17 yard, and that the said county has filed with the recorder
18 of the said city a bill for the same in the sum of \$278.25,
19 and the city had paid thereon, in an advancement to the
20 said County, in the purchase of a gravel pit near Lebanon
21 the sum of \$75.00, and there is justly owing from the said
22 County a balance in the sum of \$203.25.

23 Second 2- There is hereby appropriated out of the general
24 funds of the said city of Lebanon not otherwise appropriated
25 the sum of \$203.25 for the payment of the said improvements
26 and for the said gravel, and the recorder of the said City
27 and the mayor thereof are hereby directed and authorized to
28 draw the warrant of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, in favor
29 of Linn County, Oregon, for the said sum of \$203.25, the said
30 warrant to be paid as other warrants of the said city are paid.
31 Passed by the Council this 3rd day of December, 1918.
