

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 2 FOR 1919

2 ORDINANCE NO. 233

3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 111, passed by
4 the council of the 5th day of December 1911 and approved by the
5 Mayor on the 5th day of December 1911, as amended by Ordinance No.
6 152 passed by the council on the 3rd day of March 1914 and ap-
7 proved by the mayor on the 3rd day of March, 1914, concerning
8 the regulation of Billiard and Pool Rooms.

9 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

10 That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 111, being an Ordinance entitled
11 "An Ordinance to license, Regulate, Tax and restrain certain call-
12 ings, trades and Employments in the city of Lebanon, in Linn
13 County, Oregon, and to define what shall constitute the same, and
14 to provide for the manner of issuing licenses therefor, and to
15 provide for the punishment of any violation of this Ordinance,
16 and to repeal Ordinances No. 54, 66, 71, 90 and 92, and all other
17 Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance" as amended by
18 Ordinance No. 152 entitled "An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 111
19 in the matter of regulation of Billiard and Pool rooms," be and
20 the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

21 SECTION 10. ~~That~~ No. Minors shall be allowed to frequent
22 loiter about or be in any room or rooms or place where any
23 billiards or pools are being played for profit or hire, or where
24 such tables are kept for profit or hire, or where such tables are
25 kept ~~are kept~~ or used to attract customers or trade, or where
26 any such tables are kept in any rooms where confectionery or soft
27 drinks are sold or offered for sale, or other such places. Provid
28 ed, That Boys over eighteen years of age may visit such places
29 and play such games on present^{ly} to the proprietor or manager
30 of such place or places the written consent of his parents or
31 parent or guardian, or person having control of such minor, And
32 provided further that any person justly entitle to wear an uniform
33 of the United States as a soldier or sailor or who has been duly
34 enlisted in the Unites States army or navy or served for a period
35 of sixty days in any United States training camp or school for the
36 army or navy, shall not be required to present such written con-
37 sent: And provided further that if any parent of such soldier or
38 sailor presents to any proprietor or manager of such billiard or
39 pool room a written protest against his or son, ^{her} under the age of

1 twenty one years playing such games or vititing such places,
 2 then such proprietor or manager shall not allow such soldier
 3 or sailor to play such games or frequesnt or be in such place
 4 or places. And Provided further that all tables mentioned in
 5 this section used or kept for the purpose or attracting
 6 customers or trade shall pay the licensed required for table
 7 kept for hbre or profit. That all tables kept or used in
 8 any soft drinkings establishments are hereby declared to be
 9 tables kept for profit.
