

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 8 FOR 1915

4 An Ordinance to Amend Section 7 of Ordinance No. 196 in  
5 the City of Lebanon, Oreg, passed by the <sup>Council</sup> County on the 1st  
6 day of June, 1915 and approved by the Mayor on the 1st day of  
7 June, 1915, Entitled " An Ordinance concerning the organiza-  
8 tion of the Fire Department of the City of Lebanon, and the  
powers and duties of the officers of said department"

9 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

11 Section 1, That section seven of Ordinance No. 196 passed by  
12 the Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, on the 1st day of  
13 June, 1915 and approved by the mayor of the said city on the  
14 1st day of June, 1915 entitled & An ordinance concerning the  
15 Organization of the fire department of the city of Lebanon, and  
16 the powers and duties of the officers of the said department, be  
17 and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows.

18 SECTION 7- Each active member of the Lebanon fire department  
19 shall receive the following compensation when attending meet-  
20 ings and drills and for fighting fires:

21 For each member actually attending the monthly meetings of  
22 the fire company of which he is a member, the sum of fifty  
23 cents for each meeting, provided the city shall not pay for  
24 more then 12 meeting in any one year.

25 For each member actually attended and participating in a  
26 fire drill of the company to which he belongs the sum of fifty  
27 cent, provided the said city shall not pay for more than 10  
28 drills in any one year.

29 For each member who actually attends a fire or conflagration  
30 and assists in fighting the same, and assists in conveying  
31 the aparatus to such fire the sum of \$1.50 for each fire.

1 For any person who shall haul or convey any hose cart, chemical  
2 engine, or hook and ladder truck to any fire with any vehicle,  
3 mortar car, or motor truck or team at the request of the chief  
4 engineer of the said department, or any foreman of any such  
5 company, the sum of \$2.00 for each vehicle for each hauling.

6 A fine of of fifty cents shall be levied against any member for  
7 absence from any drill or meeting, and a fine of One Dollar *and Fifty*  
*Cents*<sup>8</sup> for absence from any fire to which his company has been called  
9 unless he shall show a sufficient excuse for such absence. The  
10 department, subject to the approval of the council shall deter-  
11 mine by general rules what shall constitute a valid excuse for  
12 such absence. Fines shall be charged against the amount due  
13 any member and a statement of such amounts and fines shall be  
14 filed quarterly with the city recorder by the secretary of  
15 the department, said statement to be certified to by the  
16 chief engineers to be correct and true, and the said statement  
17 shall show the amount due each member after deducting any  
18 fines charged against such member. The payment of the total  
19 amount due after the deducting of the fines charged and al-  
20 lowed, shall be made by warrant of the city of Lebanon, and  
21 ~~paid~~ as other warrants are paid, the same to be drawn in favor  
22 of the secretary of the department and by him ~~signed~~ turned  
23 over to the treasurer of the department to be disbursed among  
24 the members entitled thereto.
