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WHEREAS, The said Council did by resolution No. 6 for 1919 duly ascertain and determine the total probable cost of the said improvement and the amount thereof to be paid by the city of Leban on and the amount thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and property specially benefitted thereby as follows, Total probable cost thereof \$916.00, and amount to be paid by the city of Leban on to be \$250.00 and the amount thereof to be paid by the owners of the abutting real property and property specially benefitted thereby in the sum of \$666.00 and

WHEREAS, the said Council did proceed to cause the said street to be improved and the improvement to be made and done in accordance with the said petition therefor and the charter and laws of the said city. And

WHEREAS, the City engineer and Superintendent of streets did

on the 5th day of August 1919, filed with the recorder of the said city their report of the said improvment showing that the same had been made, done and completed as provided in the said petition and according to the charter and laws of the said city, which said report showed that the total cost of making the said improvement was the sum of \$817.85, and the amount thereof to be paid by the city of Lebanon to be the sum of \$231.60 and the amount thereof to be paid by the owners of the abuting real property to be the sum of \$586.25, and that the same is less than the estimated probable cost of making the same to both the said city and the said owners. And WHEREAS, on the saix 5th day nof August 1919, the said council duly adopted resolution No. 10 for 1919, wherein it duly made and adopted as assessment roll for the said improvement of the said street and therein declared the said work to have been fully done and completed in accordance with the said petition therefore and in accordance with the charter and laws of the
