2                           ORDINANCE NO. 240

3 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE CHEVOLET TRUCK FOR  
4 FIRE TRUCK AND FIRE FIGHTING, FOR THE LEBANON FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM  
5 J. S. NORTHPROP; AT A COST OF FIFTEEN HUNDRED DOLLARS AND TO PROVIDE  
6 FOR THE MANNER OF PAYING FOR SAME WITH THE WARRANTS OF THE SAID CITY  
7 OF LEBANON, OREGON.

8           THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

9           SECTION 1. That the Mayor and recorder of the City of Lebanon  
10 be and there are hereby empowered and directed to enter into  
11 a contract and agreement with J. S. Northrop for the purchase  
12 from the said J. S. Northrop of One <sup>and</sup> OneHalf ton Chevolet Truck  
13 chases for the use and the Lebanon Fire Department for and at  
14 the agreed sum and price of Fifteen Hundred, the said sum to be  
15 paid as follows:

16           Five Hundred Dollars on the first day of January 1920, Five Hun-  
17 dred Dollars on the First Day of January 1921 and Five Hundred  
18 Dollars on the first day of January 1922. The said payment to be  
19 by the warrants of the said city of Lebanon, Oregon, to be issued  
20 and dated January 1st 1920, the said warrants to bear interest  
21 from the date of their issue until paid at the rate of six per  
22 cent per annum.

23           SECTION 2. the said last two warrants shall state upon their  
24 face the date they become due and that they shall bear interest  
25 at the rate of six per cent per annum, the interest to be paid  
26 semi-annually, on the first day of July and the first day of Jan-  
27 uary until both of said warrants are fully paid.

28           SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the general funds  
29 of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, and chargeable to the fire  
30 department budget for the year 1920, the said sum of Five Hundred  
31 Dollars to the first payment on the said truck, and there is  
32 hereby appropriated out the any available funds for the two suc-  
ceeding years money sufficient to make any and all payments coming

1 due and payable on account of the purchase of the said truck both  
2 principal and interest.

3  
4 SECTION 4. That upon the signing of the said contract for the  
5 purchase of the said truck by all the parties thereto, and the de-  
6 livery of the said to the said bity by the seller thereof in good  
7 condition as agreed in the said contract, the recorder and mayor  
8 of the said city are hereby empowered and directed to issue and  
9 deliver to the said J. S. Northop the said warrants for the said  
10 sum as herein provided.

11 SECTION 5 That in as much as the city of Lebanon has no adequate  
12 fire fighting machinery and the fire hazard is great, and the fire  
13 marshal of the State of Oregon, demands a remedy at once in that  
14 regard the health and safety requires that this ordinance shall  
15 be in full force and effect at once an emergency is hereby declared  
16 to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
17 from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor  
18 passed by the Council this 5th day of December, 1919
