

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 16 FOR 1919

2 ORDINANCE NO. 246

3 AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER AND MATERIAL AND SIZE OF
4 FLUES AND CHIMNEYS? IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE
5 CLEANING OF FLUE AND CHIMNEYS.

7 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

8 SECTION 1. All fire flues and fire chimney hereafter build or
9 constructed in the city of Lebanon shall be made and constructed
10 of brick and mortar or stone and mortar and unless a tile liner
11 is used on the inside they shall be plastered on the inside from
12 the bottom to the top. Where tile liner is used the joints shall
13 be secuerly cemented or plastered. or fitted.

14
15 SECTION 2. No fire flue shall be constructed which is less than
16 8th inches by eight inches on the inside, and no fire chimney
17 shall be less than 8 inches by 12 inches inside measure.

18 SECTION 3. Not more than two six inch^{or less}/stove pipes shall be allowed
19 to enter any flue which not more than 8 ionhes by eight inches in
20 the clear inside measure. and not more than three stove pipes six
21 inches^{or less}/in diameter shall be allowed in any fire flue which is
22 less than 8 tñches by 12 inches in the clear inside measure. Not
23 nore than one stove pipe of more than 6 inches in diameter shall
24 be allowed in any flue which is 8 inches by 8 inches in diameter
25 in the clear inside measure, and not more than two stove pipes of
26 more than 6 inches in diameter shall be allowed in any flue which
27 is 8 by 12 inches in the clear inside measure.

29 SECTION 4. All flues of 8 inches by eight inches or more in the
30 clear inside measure now are hereafter built in the city of Lebanon
31 shall be thoroughly cleaned at least once a year, and all flue of
32 less than 8 by 8 inches in the clear shall be thoroughly cleaned
Page at least twice each year. All fire chimneys shall be thoroughly
cleaned at least once each year.

1 SECTION 5. All flues hereafter built in the city of Lebanon
2 shall be built from the ground or on wood or frame supports or
3 brackets securely built so that the flue shall not settle, and
4 if built upon brackets or frame the same shall be at least three
5 feet below the ceiling and the opening for stove pipes shall be
6 atleast one foot above the bottom of th brick and the pipe at
7 least two foot below the ceiling. No frame work of the building
8 which is concealed shall be within a less distance than one and a
9 half inches from the brick wall of the flue or chimney. All flues
10 and chimneys of whatever material built shall extend at least three
11 feet above the roof to be measured from the upper side of the flue
12 or chimney where it passed through the roof.

14 SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
15 with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but this ordinance does
16 repeal any part of any now existing ordinance which is not in-
17 conflict with the provisions of this ordinance. All of the provis-
18 ions of ordinance No,10 passed by the council on the on the 14th
19 day of October 1891 and approved by the ,ayor on the 14th day of
20 October 1891 which are not inclnflit herewith are hereby declared
21 to be infull force and effect.

1 SECTION 7. It shall be the duty of the chief of police and any
2 police officer and the chief of the Lebanon Fire department to see
3 that the provisions of this ordinance are complied with, and when
4 any of the said officers shall find any flue or chimney which has
5 not been cleaned as herein provided or is any a bad or dangerous
6 condition they shall notify the owner or occupant to clean the same
7 or repair the same
7/ within ten days, and if the said order is not complied with within
8 the said time they shall cause to be filed against the said person
9 maintaining the same a complaint in the Recorders Court of the
10 said city, and such person shall be arrested and brought into
11 court on the charge of violating this ordinance and shall be pun-
12 ished as herein after provided.

13
14 SECTION 8. No patent flue or chimney shall be built or used, or a
15 any kind of flue or chimney except those built and made of brick
16 and mortar or stone and mortar and made as herein provided, except
17 by a special permit from the chief of the fire department issued
18 in writing and a copy of the said permit filed with the recorder
19 of the said city, and before such permit is granted the applicant
20 shall also secure the approval of such flue or chimney from the
21 committee of the council on street and public property before the
22 same shall be built, erected or used.

23 SECTION 9. Any person failing to comply with or refusing to com-
24 ply with any order given by any officer herein named concerning
25 the cleaning or repairing any flue or chimney within the time here-
26 in provided, or violating any of the provisions of this ordinance
27 shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars nor more
28 than Fifty Dollars or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than
29 2 days nor more than twenty-five days, upon conviction thereof
30 before the Recorder's Court of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
