ORDINANCE NO. 247

AN ORDINANCE TO ENLARGE THE DUTIES OF THE CHIEF OF THE LEBANON FIRE DEPART OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS ENGAGED IN THE INSTALLING OF ELECTRIC APPLIANCES AND TO REGALATE ELECTRIS WIRING IN OR ON BUILDINGS IN THE SAID CITY AND PROVIDING FOR A PUNISHMENT OF ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corpor-SECTION1 1. 9 ation to introduce any electric lighting, heating or power wire 10 circuit or circuits or apparatus in or on any building, or awning 11 structure or addition thereof, within the corporate limits of the 12 city of Lebanon, Oregon, unless the same shall conform to all the 13 rules and regulations set forth in what is known as the National 14 Electric Code, being rules and requirements for the installation of 15 e ectric wiring and apparatus for electric light, heat and power, 16 as the same are now established, together with any amendments and 17 changes made from time to time, which code is adopted and approved 18 and made a parto of this ordinance. Before any such electric wir- ... 19 ing shall be commenced in or an any building, awning, addition or 20 structure a written permit shall be obtained from the inspector 21 of said city of Lebanon, authorizing the person, firm or corporathon 22 therein named to do and perform the said electric wiring, and desig-23 nate the location where the same is to be performed. No such elec-24 tric wiring shall be commenced as aforesaid until such permit has 25 been ontained. 26

SECTION 2. After any electric wiring has been completed in or on 27 or to any building, awning, structure or addition thereto, for 28 which a permit has been issued, the person or persons, firm or cor-29 poration who performed the same must immediately notify the inspec-30 tor of the completion of the same and must keep the said work open 31 for inspection by the said inspector to enspect the same until he Page shall have carefully examined and approved the work and ascertained

      SECTION 3 It shall be unlawful for any electric light and power

      company to do any wiring of any natureor in any building except
  16
      their own power house or substation for which a permit has not been
  17
      issued, or to make any electric connections to any building until
  18
      a final certificate of inspection and approval of the work has been
  19
      issued by the inspector.

      SECTION 4. Until the common council of the City of Lebanon shall

      appoint an inspector, there is hereby added to the duties of the

      chief of the Lebanon Fire pepartment the powers and duties of in-

      spector of Electric wiring and such inspector shall have the right

      to enter all buildings where electric wiringm exists for the purpose

      of inspection of same, and he shall not be interested directly ori

       All work concealed in any manner which will not permit of full

   inspection will not be accepted, and for each unnecessary visit

   fee of fifty cents to the original fee will be changed to and paid

No license 7 shall be granted for a less period than for one year or for less 8 thanthe fee of Ten Dollars. 9 10 SECTION 10, All ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict 11 with this ordinance are hereby repealed. 12 SECTION 11. That is as much as the city of Lebanon has no adequate 13 ordinance on the subject of electric wiring, and there is much 14 defective wiring in the said city and the life and safety of the 15 citizens are in danger and much property is in danger fromdestruch 16 tion from defective wiring, an emergency is hereby declared and 17 this ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and af-18 ter its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor. 19 Passed by the Council this 5th day of December, 1919 20 21 Approved by the Mayor this 5th day of December, 1919 22 23 the City of Lebanon 24
