

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO. 19 FOR 1919

2 ORDINANCE NO 249

3 An Ordinance Regulating Public garages and providing for the
4 material of which they may Be Constructed.

5 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
6

7 SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporations shall hereafter construct
8 lease or occupy any building as a public garage unless the same be
9 a fire proof building. Provided this does not apply to any garage
10 now in use, but all additions, alterations, and improvements to any
11 building now in use as a garage shall be made and constructed of
12 non combustibles and material.

13 SECTION 2. There shall be at all times maintained in every public
14 garage one chemical fire extinguisher of not less than two and one-
15 half gallons capacity where the floor space is less than 2000 square
16 feet, and one additional chemical fire extinguisher for every addi-
17 tional 2000 square feet of floor space used for said public garage.
18 No part of any hotel, apartment house, rooming house or lodging
19 house shall be used as a public garage.
20

21 SECTION 3. Every Public garage shall observe and comply with the
22 following regulations and requirements and rules:

23 1, No Smoking shall be allowed inside any room used as a public
24 garage, A Notice in large letters "NO SMOKING" shall be displayed
25 in a conspicuous place and manner in the said garage and at all
26 the entrances to the said garage.

27 2. Sand shall be kept on hand in iron buckets in all public gageges.
28 Every public garage of 2000 square feet or ~~more~~^{less} of floor space shall
29 also keep and have on hand at all times as least one barrel of clean
30 sand, and one additional barrel for every 4000 feet of area, placed
31 in different parts of the main floor and repair shop. Each barrel
32 to contain an iron scoop, so as to throw the sand on a gasoline
Page or oil fire or any other fire on the floor of such garage.

1 All such sand when saturated with oil or other combustibile material
2 shall be removed from the building. The use of saw dust for absorbing
3 oils in any public garage is hereby strictly prohibited.

4 3. All waste and rubbish of any kind must be kept at all times in
5 metal receptacles fitted with tight covers.

6 4. No gasoline shall be taken from or put in any automobile where
7 there is an open light. All oil or gas lamps on the automobile must
8 be extinguished before the filling of the tank with gasoline.

9 5. No light or any kind other than electricity shall be used in
10 any public garage.

11 6. No gasoline shall be used to operate any motive power for machinery
12 in any garage, except the motors in automobiles for driving the cars

13 7. No stoves, forges, torch or furnace, flame or fire shall be al-
14 lowed within any room occupied as a public garage, except in the repair
15 room of such garage which is separated from the main room of such
16 garage by a tight wall.

17 8. All electric motors not actually a part of an automobile shall
18 be located not less than four feet above the floor

19 9. All repair shop shall be kept clean and the floors free from
20 oily waste or rags; all such rags and waste shall be kept in metal
21 receptacles covered with tight fitting covers.

22 10. No oils, gasoline or other inflamable material shall be al-
23 lowed to be stored or kept in any lockers.

24 11. All lockers in any public automobile garage shall be so con-
25 structed as to permit of ready inspection.

26
27 SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this
28 ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court
29 of the City of Lebanon, be punished by a fine of not less than Five
30 Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City
31 jail not less than two days nor more than twenty-five days, and every
32 day of maintenance of prohibited conditions as herein provided

Page shall constitute a separate offense.

1 Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
2 with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
