

1 ORDINANCE BILL NO 20 FOR 1919

4 AN ORDINANCE REGLATING THE STORAGE O EXPLOSIVES.

5 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

7 SECTION 1 It shall be unlawful to store or keep any dynamite, ni-
8 troglycerin, giant powder or other explosives other than gunpowder
9 in any storeroom, wareroom, ware house, building or on any premises
10 within the corporate limits of the city of Lebanon, Oregon.

11 SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to store or keep any explosive in
12 excess of one pound in any storeroom, wareroom, building or on any
13 premises within the corporate limits of the said city of Lebanon,
14 providing that not more than five pounds of gunpowder may be kept
15 in a closed metal canisters in a store room or store or wareroom
16 away from artificail heat or light, and providing further that not
17 more than fifty pounds of gun powder may be kept if in a magazine
18 made of fireproof material or of wood covered with sheet iron and
19 mounted on wheels and kept securely locked except when necessarily
20 opened for use by authorized persons, and not more than 1000 blasts
21 ing caps in a similar but separate magazine. Said magazines shall
22 be conspicuously labeled in red letters at least three inches high
23 "EXPLOSIVES" and shall be located within ~~xxxxxxx within~~ the build-
24 ing, on the floor nearest the street level and within ten feet of
25 a street entrance.

27 SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall sell of store
28 any gunpowder shall obtain a permit from the chief of the Lebanon
29 fire department, who shall inspect the place where same is to be
30 kept, and the dealer shall fully disclose to the said chief where
31 same is kept both in the day and night time.

32 SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the

1 provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor
2 and upon conviction thereof before the recorder's Court shall be
3 fined not less than Five Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars or by
4 imprisonment in the city jail not less than two days nor more than
5 twenty-five days for each offense, and each day that any of the
6 terms of this ordinance are not complied with shall be deemed and
7 taken as a separate and distinct offense.
8

9 SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with
10 this ordinance are hereby repealed.

11 SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at
12 once, for the reason the city of Lebanon now has no adequate law
13 covering the manner of storing and keeping of explosives, and the
14 safety, peace and health of the said city is endangered, and emer-
15 gency is hereby declared to exist which requires that the provisions
16 of this ordinance be effective at once.
