

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 22 FOR 1919

Ordinance No. 257

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE COMPENDATION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AND DEFINE THEIR DUTIES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The salary of the City Attorney of the city of Lebanon shall be the sum of \$420.00 a year payable quarterly or monthly as other bills against the city are paid. He shall also receive such other compensation for ligation in state and outside Court, and other extraordinary services as the council may deem reasonable. The said salary shall be in full for other ordinary services rendered for the city including counsel and advice to City officers, litigation in the city Courts, and services for the council.

Section 2- The City recorder shall receive a salary of \$360.00 a year to be paid quarterly or monthly as other bill against the city are paid, which shall be in full for all services rendered whether as clerk of the council or municipal judge in the City Courts.

Section 3- The Marshall of the City of Lebanon shall receive a salary of \$1000.00 a year which shall be paid Quarterly or monthly as other bills against the city are paid.

Section 4 . The Marshal of the city of Lebanon shall until the Council shall otherwise provide act as Superintendent of Streets of the said city, and shall have all the powers of such officer while so acting and shall perform all the duties of that office. He shall not receive any other or additional compensation for his services as such officer other than his salary as Marshall and the salary as marshall is intended and does cover all his services whether acting as Marshall, chief of police or Superintendent of streets.
