3 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN FIRE AP-
4 PARATUS,

5 WHEREAS THE CITY OF LEBANON , Oregon, is in need of more
6 efficient fire fighting apparatus, and has already purchased
7 a Chevolet fire chases, and now needs a larger and better
8 chemical engine and ladder equipment and reels for the said truc
9 truck, and prices on these articled have been submitted by A.
10 G. Long, of Portland, Oregon, and the same are satisfactory and
11 as cheap as the same ban be secured for, THEREFORE

12 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

13 SECTION 1. That the mayor and the Recorded and the Fire Chief
14 of the Lebanon Fire Department are hereby authorized and direct-
15 ed to enter into a contract with A. G. Long of Portland, Oregon,
16 for the purchase and safe delivery in Portland, Oregon, on behalf
17 of the said city of Lebanon, of the following described fire
18 fighting apparatus and the prices herein indicated. To-wit:-

19 One 60 gallon copper chemical engine complete, mounted on
20 frame and detached from truck,

21 Hook and ladder out-fit, on frame, but detached from trucks.

22 The same being a complte chemical engine and hook and ladder
23 out fit, but detached from trucks and fit to be attached and
24 placed on the Chevolet truck chases owned by the city of Leb-
25 anon, for and at the submitted price of \$600.00, all ready
26 to be attached to said chases, and in good condition.

27 SECTION 2. On the purchase of the said apparatus the Mayor and
28 recorder are hereby authorized and directed to issue the warrant
29 of the city of Lebanon to the said A. G. Long for the payment
30 of the said apparatus in the said sum of \$600.00
