

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 4 FOR 1920
ORDINANCE NO. 255

1 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PARK COMMISSION; AND FOR THE MANAGEMENT
2 OF ALL PUBLIC PARKS AND PLAY GROUNDS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON,
3 AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANER OF ELECTING MEMERS OF SUCH COMMISSION
4 AND THEIR TWRMS OF OFFICEM AND NAMING THE FIRST MEMBERS OF SAID
5 COMMISSION.

6 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

7 SECTION 1 - There is hereby created a Park Commission for the
8 City of Lebanon, Oregon, to consist of Seven Members, at least four
9 of whom shall be men, and four of whom shall constitute a quorum
10 to transact business. The said Commission to be known as THE PARK
11 BOARD.

12 SECTION 2- The Mayor and no member of the Council while acting
13 as such officer shall be eligible to act as a Park Commissioner or
14 on the Park Board.

15 SECTION 3- The following persons are hereby appointed to com-
16 pose and comprise the first Park Board as such Commissioners and
17 to serve for the following terms, to-wit:-

- 18 Bert A. Millsap to serve for a term of One Year
- 19 Albert F. Wilson to serve for a term of two years
- 20 J. G. Gill to serve for a term of three years
- 21 Dennis Cormier to serve for a term of Four years
- 22 S. P. Bach to serve for a term of five years
- 23 A. M. Reeves to serve for a term of six years
- 24 J. C. Mayer to serve for a term of Seven years.

25 The said commissioners shall serve until the end of the term for
26 which they have been severally been elected and until their success-
27 ors have been duly elected and confirmed as hereinafter provided.

28 SECTION 4- At the expiration of the term of office of any of the
29 said Commissioners, or in case of a vacancy by resignation, death,
30 or otherwise, the office shall be filled by the election of a suc-
31 cessor by the remaining members of the Board, and if the said Election
32 be for a member at the expiration of a term then the member shall be
elected for a term of seven years; and if it be to fill a vacancy
then, for the balance of the term for which the predecessor was chosen

All election made by members of the said Commission shall be reported
to the Council and confirmed by the Council, before the same shall
be effective; and upon being confirmed by the council they shall

1 /enter upon and assume all the duties of the office of a commissioner
2 of the said Boards herein provided

4 SECTION 4- The Park Commission of the City of Lebanon, Oregon,
5 shall have full and complete charge of all public parks, play
6 grounds and other public places of amusement in the said City,
7 and shall have charge of all funds for the improvement of the
8 said parks and public places and the same shall be expended only
9 under the direction of the said Park Board, The said Park board may
10 make such rules and regulation for the government of the said parks
11 and play grounds as they may deem proper.

12 SECTION 5- The Council shall make provision in the annual city
13 budget for such funds as they deem proper to be ^{raised} ~~used and expended~~
14 by the ~~City~~ ^{said} for Park and playground purposes, and such funds shall
15 be available from time to time for the use of the said park board,
16 and the same shall be paid over to the said park board by the
17 treasurer of the City of Lebanon from time to time. The said Park
18 Board shall have no authority to bind the city for any contract
19 or for the payment of any money, and the City of Lebanon shall not
20 be liable to the said Park Board to any amount beyond that which
21 it provides in the annual budget.

22
23 SECTION 6- The said Park Board may raise funds for its own use
24 in any manner that I may deem proper, either by donations, sub-
25 scription, gifts, bequests, devices or otherwise, or by giving
26 entertainments or amusements, and such funds shall be the funds of
27 the park Board as such and expended under its directions for park
28 purposes, but no funds provided by the budget or by gifts, or by
29 any other manner for the said Park Board shall be expended for any
30 other purpose than for the maintenance and improvement of the said
31 Parks and play grounds of the said City and for equipments for the
32 same, or for buildings thereon.

1 SECTION 7- All elections for members to the said Park Board
2 shall be held and conducted in such manner as the members of the
3 said Board may provide and deem proper, and all regular elections
4 shall be held on the First Monday in December of each year and shall
5 be reported to the Common Council at it regular meeting held on the
6 Third Tuesday of December of each year, or to any other regular
7 meeting following the said election, and all special elections held
8 by the said board for member to the said board shall be reported
9 to the next regular meeting of the council following the said elec-
10 tion, for confirmation, and if confirmed such officer shall if
11 the same be a regular annual election assume the duties of the such
12 office on the first Monday in January following or as soon thereafter
13 as assuch confirmation is made. If the same be for a member elected
14 at any special election or to fill a vacancy, then such officers
15 shall take office and assume the duties thereof as soon as he is
16 confirmed by the council. In case the council shall refuse to con-
17 firm any member elected by the members to the said park Board, then
18 the predecessor shall hold office until a new member shall be elected
19 and confirmed by the council, as herein provided.

20 SECTION 8- In as much as the City of Lebanon has no public Park
21 and the health and safety and peace of the City requires that this
22 Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at once and emergency is
23 hereby declared, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect
24 from and after is passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

26 SECTION 9- This ordinance passed by the Council this 17th day of
27 February 1920 by the unanimous vote of all member of the Council
28 taken by eye and nay vote on roll call of the Council ~~and taken~~
29 entered in the journal of the Council
